Interestingly, William Robinson (a brother of John b. 1735)
Accompanied Thomas Beals, north beyond the Ohio' on a visit
to the Mingo and Delaware Indiana, in 1777.They were captured
and the affair has been recounted many times over.

It is therefore, not surprising that the great body of the
family removed to western Ohio, no doubt due to the stories
related by the aforementioned William. wch.

When White River Mo Mtg was set-off the Robinson's were under the verge of
that meeting and belonged to particular meeting of Jericho.

How Jehu again became a member of the Society is not clear, but in some
manner it came about, and removed to the West, settling (it is said)
in Missouri.

White River Mo Mtg, Randolph Co, Ind: 10 13 1841 Jehu Robinson, of Jericho,
and fam got Salem MM, Iowa Territory.

Of this family, William Robinson (1816-1902) remained in Randolph Co.
(It would appear that Jehu removed to Iowa, but in 1841 there were no
Friends' mtgs in Missouri and probably Salem MM was as close as a cert.
could be sent. wch).

Jehu Robinson, born in Virginia in 1784, Randolph County, Ind, 1822, one
and a half miles east of Winchester; owned the Kemp farm, and then to Western
Missouri; died 1858, seventy-four years old; married Mary Wilkerson; came to Ohio
in 1811, and to Washington County, Ind., in 1815; twelve children; farmer. His
wife was a Friend, and he was a strong Democrat. . . page 339, Tucker's
