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INTRODUCTION.

THE compilation of the following record of the Russell family was undertaken not with any intention of recording the history of the family or of any of its members; but to put in form for preservation such data as is now readily obtainable. The greater portion of the persons named in the sixth and seventh generations, were personally known to the compiler, and his task was very much lightened by this knowledge—which those of the younger generations would not possess.

It is not supposed that this record is fully complete or even accurate: but it is believed that it is as nearly so, as could be secured without involving the expense of considerable travel to secure personal interviews and access to family records.

FIRST GENERATION.

1. WILLIAM RUSSELL came from England between 1636 and 1645. At the latter date he was at Cambridge, Mass., where he and his wife Martha were members of the church. He had brought with him his wife and son Joseph, who was born 1636. Like many of the early settlers Mr. Russell did not at once fix on a permanent abiding place.

He died at Cambridge, Feb, 14, 1662 having made his will 12 days before. His widow, Martha, m. 2nd March 24, 1665, Humphrey Bradshaw, and 3d, May 24, 1683, Thomas Hall. She died about 1694.

It is possible that the second child was born in England, but the others were probably born in Cambridge where they were baptized.

John Russell was at Cambridge Farms, Mass. at the organization of the parish in 1693, and was the largest subscriber for the meeting house. He was one of the original members of the church in 1696, and his wife removed her relations to the church in Lexington soon after from Cambridge.

He was not only a man of wealth, but was an active and valuable citizen, and filled various offices in the parish and town.

There was another John Russell, who removed to Wethersfield, Ct.

THIRD GENERATION.

12. JOHN RUSSELL, b. Lexington, Mass.. Nov. 9, 1671, d. June 14, 1746, m. Rebecca —.

They were admitted to the church in Lexington, Mass. April 10, 1715. He appears to have been one of the proprietors of Brimfield, Mass. This town was laid out in 1701 but not settled until over twenty years later. There was much controversy over the rights of the original grantees, and the matter was not settled until 1731, when the first town meeting was held, on the 9th of November, when John Russell, Thomas Stebbins and Henry Burt were appointed a committee to oversee the work on the meeting house. John Russell was moderator of the town meeting, Dec. 28, 1731. At a proprietors meeting held Jan. 25, 1731-2, he was one of a committee of three to notify grantees to finish their grants by laying them out, and again on the 11th day of April the same year. Lot number 53 was drawn by him. He was moderator of the proprietors' meeting held July 4, 1732. The land records at Springfield, Mass., of Hampden County, then a part of Hampshire County, show deeds of his children at several times. Jan., 1750-1, John and Joseph convey land to Adonijah, two fifths, "which belonged to their father John Russell," and a transfer by the same to the same was made Jan. 17, 1755. In June, 1755, Adonijah and John convey land to Joseph "of their father," &c., and the same month John and Joseph make deed to Adonijah.

In the seating of the meeting house in 1757, Widow Rebecca Russell was seated in the pew next the pulpit on the west side.

The title to a 100 acre right in Brimfield, was conveyed May 9, 1729 to John Russell, Jun., of Lexington, by Daniel Hubbard, of Brimfield, for £565. Mr. Russell appears to have taken a leading part in all public affairs in Brimfield during his life there. All of his children settled there.
