ADDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS

A-1

to "JOSEPH RAMSEY (1747-1834)"

On August 15, 1832, when he was 85 years old, Joseph Ramsey went to Flemington, N. J. and made a statement before the court of Common Pleas when applying for a pension. It is this statement which discloses to us the known facts about his Revolutionary War service. Over a million such applications for pensions are on file in Washington, D. C. in the custody of the General Services Administration. Most interesting are the descriptions of some of his duties. For instance:

"We marched down to Amboy. And I served a month that time. After that there was call for men to turn out for five months. I volunteered. *** We went to New York. I was in the battle on Long Island under Col Phil Johnson when he was killed. ----- William Vansyckle was shot one night taking some Tories near the Readingtown meeting house. He was brought to Dr. Jennings *****Cut out the bullet and dressed his wounds. We were out a great deal on little scouting parties watching the British and tories ***I was out on militia duty at Amboy. I was out several times at Elizabeth Town and at Woodbridge at the time General Nathaniel Heard's house was burnt by the British. We had a skirmish there that time I remember one of the Americans had both his legs shot off at the knees by a ball from a field piece***** I was in the Battle at the Short Hills and one Battle at Springfield--I was out at the time of the battle of Monmouth until a day or two before the battle and was then taken sick and brought home. I was out at the time Fort Washington was taken.

David Schamp who was Joseph Ramsey's commanding officer during much of his service was called upon to make a statement affirming that the words of Joseph had been true. He said that he had known Joseph since shortly after his arrival in the country; that Joseph had come to the house of David Cole who lived between one and two miles from his (Schamp's) father and had made his home there as long as the war lasted; that he knew him well; that his statements concerning war service were correct.

Joseph prefaced his statement of service with the following one:
" I was born in the Month of May in the year of our Lord, 1747. in the north of Ireland, in the County of Down. One of my brothers and myself came into this country when I was about 20 years old. After I was in this country I wrote home for an account of my age and the clergyman sent me an extract of the entry of my birth in the parish Register. I have that yet and from that I can calculate my age."

In the "Ramsey" file in the library of the Hunterdon County Historical Society, Flemington, N. J., there is this unsigned, undated, therefore not to be considered authentic, note: "His sword is in possession of Mrs. James R. Kline, at Clinton, N. J. The silver buckles worn by him were afterward made into spoons and are now in the possession of the Field family".

The records of the Fairview, Ill., Dutch Ref. Ch. show that Joseph Ramsey's grandson, Benjamin Stevens Ramsey and wife Sarah Lowe Ramsey were admitted to membership 4-30-1853 and later were transferred to Congregational Ch., Farmington, Ill. (3-1-1865) (A letter to the second church was returned 'Not known'.) A dau., Sarah Frances Ramsey, born 7-9-1857, was baptised in the Fairview Church 9-30-1857.

Fulton County Records show that Benjamin S. Ramsey's
Will was written June 19, 1883 and filed for probate
on Oct. 15, 1883. He names his wife, Sarah M. Ramsey,
his son, Manuel K. Ramsey, his son-in-law, Thompson
Tipton and his Grandson, Wickliff Ewing Ramsey. Also
included in the estate papers with his Will were three
receipts, each for \$4996.90, as their share of Benjamin
S. Ramsey's estate. These receipts were signed by Mary
E. Shroevs, Rachel A. Tipton and Luckie C. Ramsey.

It is believed that each of the above three statements
refer to Benjamin Stevens Ramsey, often erroneously
called Stephen. Also, it has been learned that there
is no Congregational Church in Farmington, Ill. at the
present time. This information has been obtained
through the courtesy and cooperation of Mrs. William
H. Smith of Peoria, Ill.

An effort has recently been made to locate the parish records from
which Joseph Ramsey received his birth record after he had come to Amer-
ica. After reading in the New York City library of the existence of a
Vestry Book of the Parish of Down 1703-1828, the compiler wrote to the
Presbyterian Historical Society in Belfast, Ireland, asking them to
check these records for a Joseph Ramsey born in May, 1747. The entry
would undoubtedly give the names of parents. The reply from them was
evasive and disappointing and apparently they were not willing to oblige.
