FOREWORD

The following geneology was compiled in the spirit of the above quotation. While working on land and military pension records in the National Archives, Washington, D. C., the author came across the names of Daniel and Simon Shonkwiler who performed military service in an Ohio Militia Company as riflemen or sharpshooters during the War of 1812-15. That was the start of the search which has covered many years and a great deal of travel.

This family history tells the story of one man and some of his descendants who in their humble way helped to make this Republic a mighty nation. The story of their migration from Pennsylvania through Kentucky, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Iowa, Missouri and Kansas is typical of the way the new states were carved out of the wilderness by our pioneer ancestors a hundred years ago.

Daniel Shonkwiler and his descendants fought Indians, cleared the forests, plowed the praries, fought fire, famine, floods, fever, and loneliness to establish homes in the new states of the old Northwest. Their sufferings and sacrifices helped make possible our present way of life.

Much of the source material was found in the records of the county court houses. Staff members of these courthouses located in Monticello, Illinois; Greencastle and Rockville, Indiana; Centerville, Iowa; and Portsmouth and Waverly, Ohio, were especially courteous and cooperative in locating records and making suggestions concerning other sources of information.

ARRANGEMENT

A simple Arabic numbering system has been used in the history for tracing lines of descent and ascent. Arabic numerals are also used after the given name to indicate generation, and the head of each family is followed with a string of names (enclosed in parentheses) which shows his or her line of descent from the first Shonkwiler of record settling in the United States. Children are listed in order of birth (when known) and are assigned small type Roman numerals. Children's names are not repeated if they died before marriage, did not marry, or if there is no information concerning them. Each family is completed as the records are carried forward, and the Arabic control numerals can be easily followed. Abbreviations include "b." for born, "d." for died, and "m." for married. Names of months and states have also been abbreviated.

In the compilation of this data, errors in cophing may have been overlooked and sometimes names may have been left out, expecially of recent births, marriages and deaths. Corrections and insertions were made whenever possible. Those received too late for insertion, or those too extensive to include in their regular position, have been included on the Addenda or back page of the geneology.

THE SHONKWILER FAMILY IN AMERICA

The name Shonkwiler probably comes from the German word "shöen" or beautiful and "weiler"--village or town--a word derived from the Italian "villa" or French "viller".

The Shonkwiler family is of German descent and according to one tradition was of noble origin. It is said that Simon Von Shunk or Shonkwiler, the founder of our branch of the family in America, was a member of the court of a German Prince.

Another legend relates that a Shonkwiler became annoyed at the destruction of his crops wrought by the King's wild boars, killed one of the boars and stopped the hole in the fence with the animal's carcass. The killing of the King's wild game was a criminal offense punishable by death or imprisonment and Simon and his family over night had to flee the country.

However fanciful or truthful these tales are, the Pennsylvania Archives show that one Jacob Schanckweiler arrived in Philadelphia on the ship Prince of Wales, sailing from Rotterdam, Holland via Cowes, England and took the oath of allegiance to King George III on November 5, 1764. He settled near Allentown, Macungie Township, Northampton Co., Pennsylvania.

Other Shunkwilers of early record were John Adam, who arrived in Philadelphia on the ship Montague, sailing from London, and took the oath of allegiance to King George III on December 8, 1773; and Jacob and Adam Shunkwiler who were taxed in Hopewell Township, York County, Pennsylvania in 1781-82.

Some of the descendants of these Shunkwilers took an active part in Fries rebellion in Western Pennsylvania in 1798.

Little is known of the family, also spelled Shankwiler and Shunkweiler

in Pennsylvania. There are many descendants of Jacob Schanckweiler living in and near Allentown and Altoona. There are other families living at Erie, Lewistown, Paxton and Clearfield, but an attempt to trace their relationship to the Ohio Shonkwilers was inconclusive.

Nelson W. Evans, in his "History of Scioto County, Ohio" states
"George Adam Shonkwiler, Senior, received a good education in Germany. He
came to America in 1797 bringing with him his wife, Elizabeth, five boys and
two girls, Simon, Daniel, Jacob, George Adam, Jr., David, Elizabeth and
Christina. (He also had one grown daughter married in Germany to a man
Named McCoy.) They came to Scioto County via Pennsylvania and Kentucky about
1800 and settled in what is known as Fink Bottom, about four miles northeast
of Sciotoville. Here Simon Shonkwiler, Senior died."

George Adam, Senior married twice. Daniel, David, Jacob, Christina, Elizabeth and Mrs. McCoy were children of his first wife. John Simon and George Adam, Junior were sons of the second marriage.

Little is known about the families of David, Jacob, Christina,
Elizabeth and Mrs. McCoy. The Scioto County marriage register records the
marriage of Elizabeth Shonkwiler (Shunkwiler) and Martin Collins on August 7,
1815, and Christina Shonkwiler (Shunkwiler) to William Plumb January 31, 1816.

The Collins and Plumb families later moved to Texas.

Martin Collins, William Plumb, Daniel and Simon Shonkwiler (Shunkwiler) enlisted in Captain John Lindsay's Company of Ohio militia July 29, 1813, part of a regiment recruited in Scioto County by Colonel John Ferguson. The company was part of a force rasied to relieve Fort Meigs (now

Toledo) beseiged by Indians and British troops. They were discharged September 9, 1813 after the siege had been abandoned by the British.

Daniel, Senior and George Adam, Jr., sons of George Adam, Senior, purchased 147 acres of government land in Union Township, Scioto County, Ohio, in 1815 and engaged in farming.

The brothers, John Simon, George Adam, Jr., Daniel, Senior, and other members of the family migrated to Parke and Putnam counties, in Indiana about 1823. Daniel purchased government land in Clinton Township, Putnam County September 14, 1825 and lived on it until his death in 1853. John Simon, Senior, farmed in Putnam and Parke County from 1825 until 1842, then moved to Piatt County, Illinois and lived there until 1857. He moved back to Indiana and settled near Independence, Warren County, Indiana, where he remained until his death during the Civil War period.

George Adam, Jr., returned to Ohio and farmed near Sciotoville until his death in 1862. Descendants of these men later migrated to other parts of Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Iowa, Missouri, Minnesota, Michigan, Texas, Nebraska, Kansas, California, Oregon, Washington and Canada.

Indiana had been a state less than ten years when Daniel Shonkwiler, Senior and members of his family migrated from Scioto, Ohio to Putnam County, Indiana. Land records show that Daniel and his half brothers George Adam, Junior and John Simon bought land near Greencastle, Indiana in 1825 after moving there in 1823. He was accompanied by his sons Simon, Daniel, Jr., Adam, David and Nathaniel and his daughters Julia, Nancy and Margaret. During the next decade the children migrated to Illinois, Iowa and Missouri.
