All settled in Pennsylvania.

Born July 24, 1767, married Margaret Bart, December 8, 1792.

In 1857 Stephen Richardson was elected a deacon and ordained in the ministry in the *Church of the Brethern in Christ*, ("River Brethern") of which he became a member in 1855, and of which Sarah Richardson also became a member at the same time.

He served as a local minister through life. He was a farmer all his life.

It is also noted that Christian Stauffer was a preacher in the Church of the Brethern in Christ, sometimes known as the "River Brethern" Church, an offshoot of the Mennonite Church. The Church of the Brethern in Christ was founded by Jacob Engle, a Swiss Mennonite, in 1776 in Pennsylvania, who had come to America. Many in the Stauffer family, for some generations up to the present, were members of the Church of the Brethern in Christ.
