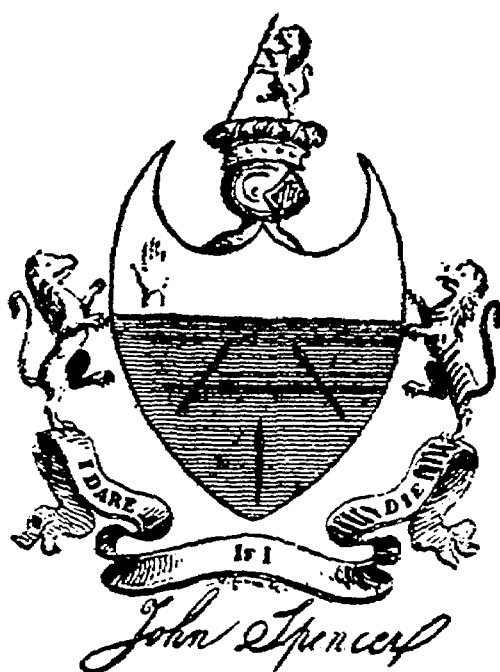

# Are They Crowning Washington's Cousin?

LONDON, England.

**W**HEN YOUNG Queen Elizabeth II is crowned here next month Americans can feel a family relationship. *Through her mother, she is a distant relative of our own George Washington—the man who led the American Revolution against her ancestor, George III. What's more, she's the first reigning sovereign to be a Washington kinaman. No British ruler before her ever was.*

Family records, traced for PARADE on both sides of the Atlantic, show that they had common ancestors in both America and England.

## HERE'S THE ENGLISH SIDE OF THE PICTURE:

Elizabeth is the granddaughter of the Earl of Strathmore.

The Strathmores are relatives by marriage of the Spencers. (So are the Churchills—the family of cigar-smoking "Winnie.")

Early in the 1600s, the Spencers married into the Washington family, before any of its members had come to America.

(To keep the record straight, the original spelling of Washington was "Wessington"—the name of the English manor and village George's 12th Century ancestor leased from the Bishop of Durham in 1183 A.D. It didn't become "Washington" until years later.)

## AND HERE'S THE AMERICAN STORY:\*

Colonel Augustin Warner, an American colonist born in 1643, had two daughters—Mildred May and Mary.

Mildred May became George Washington's grandmother.

Mary, the other daughter, married a man named John Smith.

Their daughter, Mildred Smith, married Robert Porteus, of Virginia.

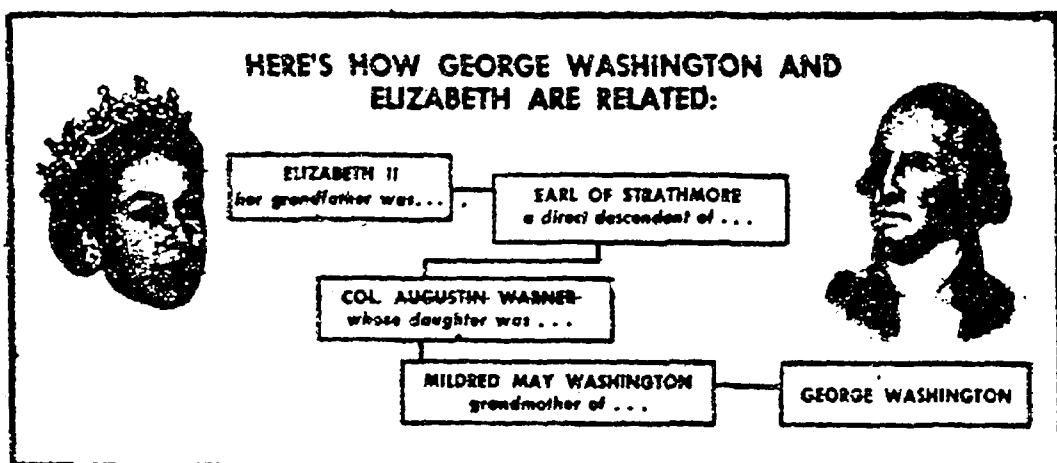
In 1720, Porteus moved his family to Yorkshire, England.

His granddaughter, Mildred Porteus, married Englishman Robert Hodgson.

The Hodgson's granddaughter, Henrietta Mildred Hodgson, married Oswald Smith, of Blendon Hall, Kent, England.

Their grandson was the 14th Earl of Strathmore, the grandfather of Queen Elizabeth II.

And so, through Mildred May and Mary Warner, the Queen and George Washington are distant cousins!

Thomas F. Spencer of Eton Secno, England, in 1433.

Robert Spencer, of South Mylles, Bedfordshire, later St. Albans, England. Married Ann Peck (Peake, Peak, Peek, Pack).

## FOURTH GENERATION

John Spencer, South Mylles, Bedfordshire 1533 at St. Albans, later in Edworth, Bedfordshire, England. Married Christian Baker.

Michael B. Spencer, of Edworth, and Statford Court, England. Married 1st Anne or Annis Lorimer (Lincer, Munier) who was buried February 23, 1561. They had two sons and one daughter.

## SEVENTH GENERATION

Gerard Spencer, baptized May 20, 1576 at St. Mary's Parish, Statford, England. He died before his brother Richards' will was proved June 8, 1646. Richards' will mentions Gerard's children.

Gerard Spencer married Alice Whitbread and they had eight children.

Gerard did not come to the U. S. Children of Gerard Spencer and Alice Whitbread.

- 1—William Spencer, baptized Oct. 11, 1601. Came to the U. S. in 1630. Died at Hartford, Conn., in 1640.
- 2—Elizabeth Spencer, baptized Oct. 21, 1602.
- 3—John Spencer, baptized June 22, 1604. Came to the U. S.; but returned to England.
- 4—Henry Spencer, baptized August 11, 1603, died 1607.
- 5—Thomas Spencer, baptized March 29, 1607, died 1687. He was known to be living in Cambridge, Mass., in 1632.
- 6—Richard Spencer, baptised Dec. 11, 1608, died 1611.
- 7—Michael Spencer, baptized May 5, 1611. He died in 1653 at Lynn, Mass.
- 8—Gerard Spencer, baptized April 25, 1614 at Statford, England. Settled at Haddam, Conn. Will probated 1685 at Hartford, Conn.

Mass. Bay Records to 1686, Vol. I, 1628-1641, "Ordered that there shall be a planteen settled at Wenecunnett and Mr. Dumer and Mr. John Spencer shall have power to presse men to build houses forwith in some convenient place, and what money they lay out, it shall be repaid them again out of the treasury ,or by those that come to inhabit there. March 3, 1635-6.

The Spencer House, Newbury, Essex County, Mass., built by John Spencer between 1648-50, a young English gentleman to whom the Estate on which the house stands was willed by his uncle, Captain John Spencer in 1637. Located east of the City of Newburyport. Uncle died in 1647.

### SPOOR FAMILY

A brief outline of the early Spoors as copied from The Spoor Family Book.

Names were changed according to where the people came from as:- Jan Wybesse Van Harlenger from the town of Harlenger, cost of Friesland—Next as purchasing land in Catskill 1662 on the Leveridge Patent of Elder Gerbertsen Cruyf, near So. bank of Catskill River. Next Jan Wybesse Spoor purchasing land Niskayuna, east of Schenectady (Lisha's Kill). A daughter Antje perished in a massacre by French and Indians 1689 or 1690. Hans or Jan became Johannes or Johannis, Hendrick became Henricus, Ellen became Lane, Sophia became Fytie.

Greene County, N. Y. was set apart from Albany Co., and Ulster Co., before 1800 with Coxsackie and Catskill. Athens, N. Y. was taken from the middle. The old Lutheran Church 1703 was known as Loonenburg, now Athens, N. Y.

Jan Yybesse Spoor acquired land of Johannes Chite at Nispayuna, between Albany and Schenectady 1685 again 1697. 1 and 2 Book of Deeds, Albany 3 and 4, pp. 286—pp. 105. His family consisted of 1 man, 1 woman, and 6 children.

He had with him at the time three young sons, Isaac, Jacob, and Cornelius. After settling sons on these land, Capt. Johannes Spoor returned to New York, since he joined the church at Albany from Kinderhook, N. Y. in 1740. He held office of Constable in Albany (3rd Ward) in 1735, again in 1736. Doc. History N. Y. 3-704. He was one of

the sturdy Protestant Yeomen of the Hudson River settlement. Moved from place to place to secure better conditions for his large family. Time of his death is unknown.
