PHILIP¹ SHERMAN, born 5 Feb. 1610, in Dedham, Essex County, England, was the son of Samuel and Thillipa (Ward?) Sherman. He came to America in 1633, settling in Roxbury, Mass.; married in 1633, Sarah Odding, daughter of Mrs. John Porter by her first marriage. In 1638 he removed to N. I., and became one of the settlers of Portsmouth. He was a large land holder, a prosperous farmer, a prominent man of affairs, and the first Secretary of the Colony. His wife died in 1681; and he died in 1687. Of their thirteen children, the third was:

PELEG² SHERMAN, born 1638, in Portsmouth, N.I. He married, 25 July 1657, Elizabeth² Lawton, daughter of Thomas¹ Lawton, born 1639. She died 1711. He died in 1710. He was an enterprising citizen, owning extensive property, and he held an honorable position among his fellow citizens. The eldest child of Peleg and Elizabeth was THOMAS.

* The inscription on her tombstone in St. Paul's Churchyard reads "May 12: 1763"; but Court Records show that she died in May 1762. Born June 29, 1724 she was in her 38th year, - or 37 years of age when she died. The inscription reads "Aged 37 years".

The tombstone is of much later date than 1762, and the error in the year is thus accounted for.

Benjamin Sherman first settled in Genesee Co., N. Y. He was a contractor on the Erie Canal, from Mt. Morris to Rochester. Removed to Michigan in 1827, settling in St. Joseph County, of which he was a Representative in 1835-6. He was Register of Land Office at Ionia, Mich., under the administrations of Van Duren and Pierce. (Vide, "Michigan Biography")

James Sherman was a farmer in Locke, Cayuga Co, N.Y.,
 from 1820 to 1851, when he removed to Virginia and
 bought "Ash Grove" where he died. In Locke he was a
 prominent citizen, leader in the Methodist Church, and
 an active Mason. In Virginia he held some local offices
 up to the time of the Civil War. He was a strong Abolitionist.
