THE TOPPAN FESTIVAL.

On the afternoon of the 24th day of June, 1846, one hundred and fifty of the lineal and legal descendants of Edward and Sarah Toppan assembled at the old homestead in Toppan's lane, Newbury. It was a meeting in part of strangers, yet being relatives, a long acquaintance was not needful to ensure kindly greetings. Formality was dispensed with, and all entered at once into the spirit of the occasion.

The pleasures of the family circle are peculiar, and though many are thus encircled, the gratification is not diminished. No one could have surveyed this large company,—some venerable with age, others in the strength and maturity of manhood, others exhibiting the activity and bloom of youth, and still others in the sportiveness of childhood, or the feebleness of infancy,—and have claimed an interest in them all, without unwonted emotions. They were friends, and friendship among strangers is as cooling water to the thirsty soul. They were intelligent and respectable, and such connections are a wall of strength. The interview was mostly of a social nature, yet select portions of Scripture were read, and prayer was offered by the Rev. George H. Atkinson to the "God of our Fathers." His word had been their law and guide. His blessing had been bestowed upon them during many generations and that day bore witness to His continued goodness.

The following letter from a member of the family, Rev. Benjamin Hale, D. D., President of Geneva College, was read :

GENEVA COLLEGE, June 20, 1846.

TO MRS. ANN HARRIS—

My Dear Aunt: I regret that I cannot accept the invitation to be present at the Toppan festival on the 24th, at the old house which has been the abode of so many generations of the Toppan family, and the hospitality of which I, with so many of the offspring, have in former days enjoyed. My duties necessarily keep me at home, or I should with great pleasure make one of the numerous assembly, which will, I presume, be present to commemorate the worth of our common ancestors, and to cultivate the kindly sentiments which are proper for the descendants of a common stock. As I cannot be present I address to you, my dear aunt, the venerable representative of the former generation, a few words, to assure you of the interest I take in this family re-union. The occasion of it brings strongly to my mind those of the past generation whom I have known, and whose memory will be always dear to me : your venerable mother, whom I used to see, with my venerable great grandmother, her sister, and their brother, Gen. Jacob Bailey, and their sister-in-law, who lived on to her 106th year, bearing her meek testimony to the love and faithfulness of her Heavenly Father, your sister, my excellent grandmother, your brothers, living in kindness and harmony side by side till they all went down to the grave in full age. I cannot write their eulogy, nor need I. It is in the hearts of many who will be at the festival, and the younger ones may learn of them from those who will be best able to tell of their virtues. They are beyond the reach of our thanks for their care and faithfulness to us their descendants. You, my venerable aunt, are yet with us, and you have the satisfaction of seeing, that those who have gone of your own generation are gratefully and fondly remembered, and on such an occasion as this I cannot refuse myself the satisfaction in expressing my love and reverence for the memories of the departed, to add my grateful acknowledgements of your kindness to me in my early years and for the many hours spent pleasantly and profitably in your society. May the blessing of God be with you personally, and with all those who will be assembled with you.

Before the repast "the historian of Newbury" related some incidents respecting our ancestors, and among other remarks alluded to their economy, which was not only a virtue but a necessity, a consequence not only of their principles but of the circumstances in which they were placed. A tea-pot, cup and saucer of diminutive size, were produced to show the prudent use of the much loved beverage. If small expenditures are the

test of economy, our grandmothers were indeed prudent; but if ability to expend furnishes the scale of measurement, the palm may not be so readily yielded to them. Our ancestors according to their ability would have the comforts and luxuries of their day. We do nothing more.

The good things of the table having been generously distributed, the following lines composed by Miss Fanny Johnson, a member of the family, written for the occasion, were read :

Again,* beneath our Friendship's tree,
We meet a joyful company,
A kindred birth to claim ;
And still as cousins seek to feel
Each other's woe, each other's weal,
Though differing oft in name.

The homestead, where our fathers dwelt,
Around its fireside altar knelt,
Bids " WELCOME "† at the door,
To all who here still claim a home,
Or those in distant lands who roam,
Or seek a foreign shore.

The old with reverence due we'll meet,
The smiling babe we'll fondly greet,
And, 'mid the general flow
Of kindly feelings of the heart,
Which happiness and joy impart,
The hours shall softly flow.

Our simple gifts we'll gladly bring,
Trusting that to the slightest thing
Love will true value bring ;
While each shall long possess the power
To bring us back this joyful hour,
And in our memory live.

The social board we'll gather round,
On every side with plenty crowned,
And, as each moment flies,

Our hearts in gratitude we'll lift
To Him who gives each perfect gift,
And all our wants supplies.

That blessings from our Father's hand
May rest upon our little band,
Shall be our earnest prayer;
And that, though here we may not meet
Again to join in converse sweet,
These blessings we may share.

Then let us, 'neath our Friendship tree
Extend our kindly sympathy
To kindred heart and name;
And ever may we thus retain
The friendship formed in Toppan's lane,
In weal or woe the same.

The company then united in singing to the tune of Auld Lang Syne the following lines, written for the occasion by Joshua Coffin, a member of the family:

Come, cousins, uncles, aunts, and all,
Whose faces here we see
Together met, at friendship's call,
A happy family.

Come, hands and hearts and voices join,
Not one of us be napping,
Unite in praise of Auld Lang Syne,
Descendants of A. Tappan.*

Come, we are all of Abraham's* seed,
And good old Sarah's,† too,
Each one an Israelite indeed,
Firm, honest, kind and true,

We likewise are of Jacob's‡ race,
And fathful Hannah's* line,
Names that will always have a place
In history divine.

From Edward, too, a royal name,
Our lineage we trace,
More worthy of right royal fame
Than half the royal race.

Honor to good Aunt Harris, then,
 Long may she live ; the last,
 The sole surviving link that binds
 The present to the past.

Blessings on all the Toppan race,
 Of every age and name,
 Where'er may be their dwelling place,
 Whatever be their fame.

Oft to us all, while life shall last,
 Meetings like this be given,
 And when on earth our days are past,
 May we all meet in heaven.

Another season of pleasant intercourse being passed, all the company, some of whom of both sexes were attired in the costume of a former age, assembled around the Friendship Tree,

———" but never I ween,
 " Did tree from the pole to the tropics between,
 " Bear such fruit as on this tree was seen—
 " Pin-cushions, needle-books, watch-pockets and purses,
 " Boxes, bags, all sorts of nick-nackery, even verses."

All joined in the pleasure of distributing the mementoes. For "good Aunt Harris" there was many a token.

In due time, after singing the 113th hymn, 1st book, beginning with

"How large the promise, how divine,
 To Abraham and his seed,"

all retired to their homes, weary indeed, yet grateful for the interview. The following day brought no sad remembrance of the "party." There was general satisfaction. Family ties had been strengthened, new ties had been formed, and as days and years pass away, that scene shall be vivid in the memory of

every one who lives as its witness. That company will not meet again on earth, "May we all meet in heaven."

For the convenience of relatives a family record is appended. One more extended is in the course of preparation. It will be in possession of the oldest members of the family of the Toppan name, living in Newbury or Newburyport.

The name Toppan was originally Topham, taken from the name of a place in Yorkshire, meaning upper hamlet or village. The pedigree, as far back as we have traced it, commences with Robert Topham, who resided at Linton, near Pately Bridge, supposed to be in the west riding of Yorkshire. He made his will in January, 1550. His second son, Thomas Topham, was of Arncliffe, near Linton. He died in 1589, and was buried in the church at Arncliffe. Edward Topham alias Toppan, eldest son of Thomas Toppan, was of Aiglethorpe, near Linton, and has his pedigree recorded in the college of arms with armorial bearings. One of his sons was a Lieutenant-Colonel in the service of Charles I., and was killed at Marston Moor in 1644. William Toppan, fourth son of Edward Toppan of Aiglethorpe, lived for some time at Calbridge, where his son Abraham was baptised April 10th, 1606. The family still exists in England, and are now of Middleham in the northwest part of Yorkshire on the river Ouse. The crest is a Maltese cross. As early as 1637 Abraham Toppan resided at Yarmouth. His wife was Susanna Taylor, a daughter of a Mr. Taylor and his wife Elizabeth. After the death of Mr. Taylor, the widow Elizabeth married a Mr. Goodale. After the death of Mr. Goodale she came to Newbury, where she died April 8th, 1647. Her four daughters were Susanna, the wife of Abraham Toppan; Joanna, the wife of Mr. John Oliver, and of Capt. William Gerrish; Elizabeth, the wife of Mr. John Lowle; and Ann, the wife of Capt. Thomas Milward, all of Newbury. In the first volume of the fourth series of the publications of the Massachusetts Historical Society, pp 98 and 99, is the following :

"A Register of the names of such persons, who are 21 years and upward and have license to passe into forraigne parts from

March 1637 to the 29th of September, by virtue of a Commission of Mr Thomas Mayhew, Gentleman."

Among these persons are the following :

"Abraham Toppan Cooper aged 31, Susanna his wife aged 31, with their children Peter and Elizabeth, and one mayd servant Anne Goodin aged 18 years, sailed from Yarmouth 10 May 1637 in the ship Rose of Yarmouth, Wm Andrews Master."

In October, 1637, Abraham Toppan was in Newbury, as appears by the following extract from the town records :

"Abraham Toppan being licensed by John Endicott Esqr. to live in this jurisdiction, was received into the town of Newberry as an inhabitant thereof and have promised under his hand to be subject to any lawful order that shall be made by the towne."

For March comes not with chilling winds
Each tender bud to blast,
