INTRODUCTION

As far as I have been able to determine, the parentage of William Thompson, of Leicester, Mass., has never been established. It is generally believed, by genealogists and by some of his descendants, that he came to New England in 1718 as one of 319 so-called Scotch-Irish pioneers who arrived in Boston in August of that year. It is also generally believed that he was a nephew of James Thompson, of Holden, Mass. who was one of those 319 pioneers.

who probably also was one of that group of pioneers and who married, in Rutland, Mass., on March 2, 1732, Ruth, only known daughter of James Thompson of Holden. In his will made on September 2, 1756, Hugh Thompson, of Holden named William Thompson, of Leicester, one of his executors and he referred to him as his brother.

The first reference to William Thompson is to be found in the Town of Holden, in 1726, when he and a cousin, Samuel Thompson, bought a home farm. William was among the earliest settlers of Leicester.

That portion of the Town of Leicester in which William resided was set off as a part of the Town of Paxton in 1765. At the first Town Neeting of Paxton, March 11, 1765, William was one of the Town Wardens. The records of the Town always referred to him as William of Leicester.

In a genealogy of "James Thompson of Holden, Mess. and His Descendants", compiled by Nessrs. Smith and Thompson, in 1932, a partial account is included of William, of Leicester and his early descendants. In several instances, the information contained in the following pages will differ with the information to be found in the aforementioned record. In all such instances, the data contained herein are believed to be correct, as my information somes from official Town records.

Thorough research of published and unpublished records of the many Towns in which members of this family lived, has preceded the preparation of this record. Granted the record is far from complete, it is the first comprehensive account of descendants of William Thompson, in the male line, which is known to have been published.

Rec. 59,112) On February 5 and March 4, 1777, Samuel Denny was appointed Guardian for above named children, except John, then of age.

On July 6, 1790, Aaron Easterbrook was appointed Guardian for David Thompson, ac. 15 yrs, child and heir of William Thompson deceased, of Paxton. (Hampshire County Probate Record, 147-41.)

In the will of Miriam Thompson, of New Braintree, singlewoman, made August 12, 1849, probated May 24, 1855, she named Samuel Mixter of New Braintree, Executor and made bequests to brother David Thompson, his widow or heirs; to Ithamar Thompson; Charles Hoar, son of Charles Hoar, deceased; Melina Thompson and her two sons, Silas and Millen Thompson, In April 1856, Samuel Thompson approved the accounting, (Wercester County Probate Record, #59,064.)
