Mr. & Mrs. John H. Schneider of Winnetka, Illinois
dedicated many years of their lives to the study and
research which made possible this Thayer Genealogy.

The Schneiders published the genealogies of other

Kyneton House, Thornbury, Gloucestershire, England

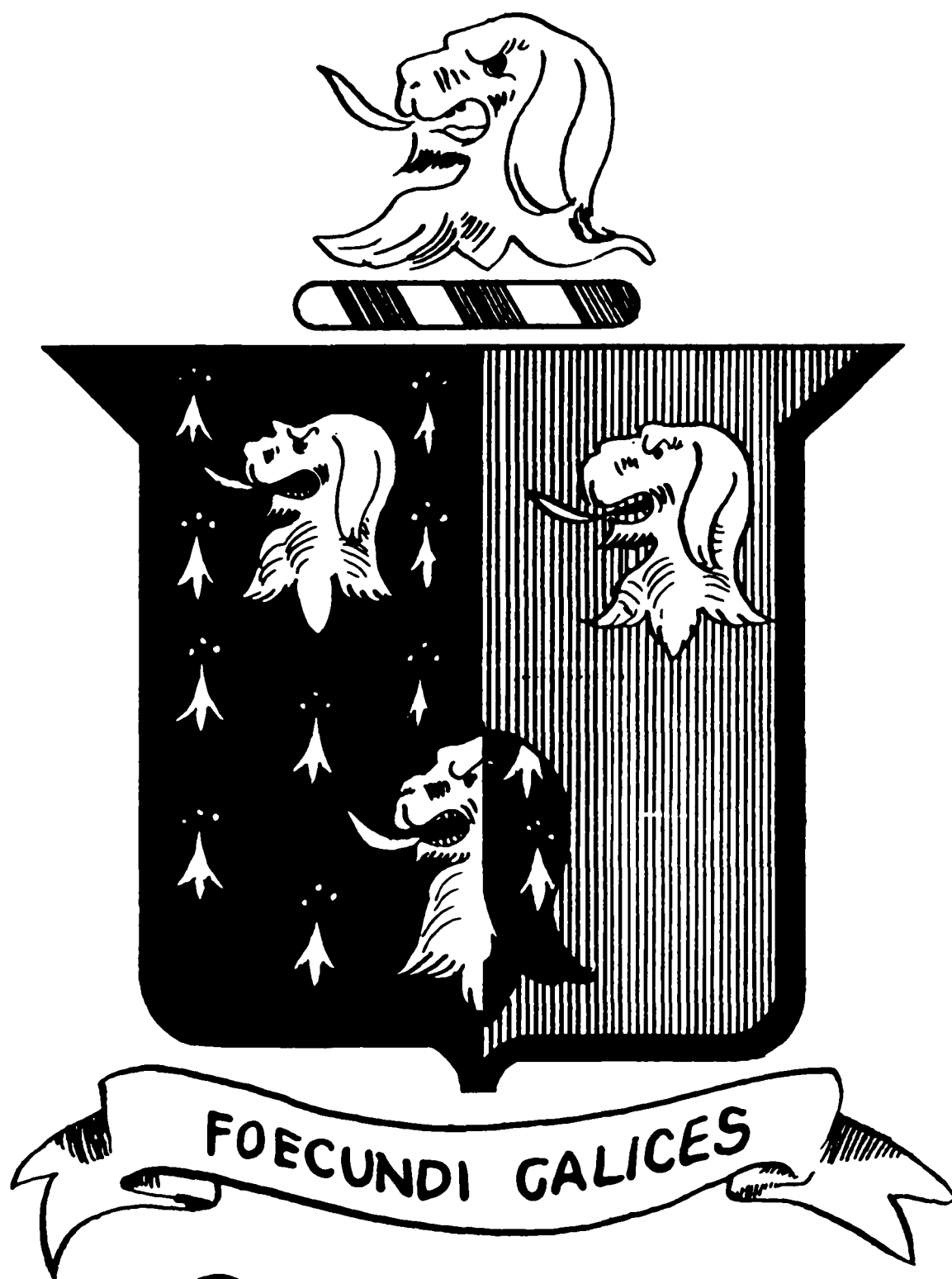
Several historians have written books on the history of the Thayer family, and it has been found that the name Thayer, in various spellings, is written into the records of England as far back as the time of Edward II (1307-1327). At that time the "Tayers" held 1000 acres, called the lands of Kyneton House at Thornbury, Gloucestershire, England. Kyneton is Saxon for King's Village. Thornbury ("Torn or Turne" Saxon for "Court") is on the site of one of the old British Kings. There are still to be seen between the village and the river, the remains of two Roman camps, for the Roman armies in the different invasions of Wales, crossed the Severn at Thornbury, as below Thornbury the river is very wide and deep.

In all the different wars from the time of the Romans down to the present day, there have been more or less fighting over these lands. The oak of which the Navy of England was of the most part built, grew on the valley of the Severn. Kyneton House standing on these lands in 1882 was built in 1603 and since added to, and was owned by William Osborne Macclaine, Esq., who was a Tayer on his mother's side.

Richard Thayer, who was the progenitor of the Wisconsin branch of Thayers, came from Thornbury, England, and his parents also lived there. One historian, Thomas Thayer Ojeda, has attempted to trace Richard's progenitors from 1520, but as records were not complete, and as Thayer was spelled so many different ways as Taweir, Teir, etc., he cannot be sure that he is correct. He and other historians agree that the father of Richard and his brother Thomas, who emigrated to New England, was a Richard who married _____ Dimmery.

In England there were Thayers located at Brockworth in the county of Gloucestershire as early as 1542. In 1907 there were still standing two houses belonging to Thayers of this line, built at the time of King James I, (1603-1625). In the upstairs bedroom of one of these are two stone faces of an animal, which may have been the crest or badge of the Thayer family.

There is a coat of arms of the Thayer family recorded at Lincolnfield Heraldic Office. According to historian Bezalul Thayer, it was presented to Augustine Thayer, of Theydon, a small village in the eastern county of Essex, and about 18 miles north of London. A description found of the arms of the Thayer, of Theydon, Essex; per pale, ermine and gules, three talbots heads erased counterchanged. Crest a talbots head erased. Pet fesse ermine and gules.

Mr. Henry Ernest Woods, A.M., says that the root of the family name is "taw", meaning to dress skins.

Rev. Canon Bazeley, secretary of the county archaeological society of Gloucester, has collected information on the Thayer family, especially of Brockworth, and has printed a pamphlet which is the beginning of a large study to get the connection of every family of the name of Thayer in England that he believes to be of the same origin.

According to historian Bezaliel Thayer, from the best information he can get, Richard and Thomas must have come to America with the Massachusetts Colony in 1630 or thereabouts, as they were found with many other families that came from Braintree, Essex County, England, who named their new town the same as the one they left in England.

It is the good fortune of the descendents of Richard and Thomas Thayer that there is an active historical society at Braintree, Mass., which has for its historian Miss Marion S. Arnold, who is descended from both the Richard and Thomas lines and has made it a life work to collect data on the history of these families and of Braintree. We are indebted to her for much of the material in this history and in helping correct errors in the first edition of this compilation.

Mr. Stacy Baxter Southworth is headmaster at the Thayer Academy at Braintree, President of the Braintree, Mass. Historical Society, and appointed by Gov Saltonstall as Chairman of the Board of Free Public Library Commissioners.

It is of great interest to know that in 1930 Mr. Walter Hunnable of Braintree, England visited at Braintree, Mass., and brought pictures with him of the lands of Kyneton House, of Kyneton House itself, and of the church which the Thayers of Thornbury attended and which dates back to about 1340, and was completed by the Duke of Buckingham in 1511. Henry VIII, Anne Boleyn, Princess Mary--later Queen Mary--the daughter of Katherine of Aragon, were all associated with the history of this church. Miss Arnold of Braintree has negatives of these pictures, as well as of those early homes in Braintree, Mass. Miss Arnold has written a history of early Braintree, Mass., published Jan. 1935 in the "Bulletin of the Bay State Historical Society."

(In 1940 Braintree celebrated its 300th Year as an incorporated town. A brief History of the Town of Braintree in Mass., prepared for the Observance of the Tercentenary Celebration of its founding in 1640-1940, was compiled and written for the Tercentenary Committee-Marion Arnold, Editor. The booklet is entitled "Old Braintree - 1640.")

Richard¹ built the Thayer Garrison House on what is now known as Elm St., and the creek in Braintree. It was overlooking the Monatiquet River.

Richard² purchased lands as follows: Thirty acres of his father in 1648, which included the Garrison House; five acres of John Gurney in 1661; eight acres of George Aldrich in 1663; thirty acres of Lyonnell Wheatley in 1667; thirty acres of John Payne in 1667. He mortgaged to Symon Lynde in 1678 his lands, consisting of seventy-five acres south of Monatiquot River and East of Middle Street, and 51½ acres north side of the river. The present Elm and Adams Streets run thru the last lot where resided.

The Nathaniel³ home which he built in 1720 still stands on Washington Street, Braintree and is beautifully preserved by the present occupants. Prior to moving to the new home in South Braintree he lived at the Richard² homestead.

Nathaniel³ Thayer was the progenitor of Sylvanus Thayer, the distinguished engineer, formerly commander for the National Military School of West Point, who is called the "father" of West Point.

Joshua⁷ Thayer married (2) Mrs. Martha E. Morse, Feb. 6, 1867. No children. Joshua moved to Palmyra, Wis. in 1842 where he owned a farm of over 500 acres. He lived at this homestead from 1842 until his death, Dec. 23, 1897.

"Joshua Thayer, farmer, Sec. 19 and 30, P.O. Palmyra, born in Berkshire Co., Mass., Aug. 16, 1820; he is among the very first settlers in Southern Wisconsin, as he came to Rock County in December 1837, and settled in Fulton where he engaged in the usual work of opening up a new country; he removed to the farm he now owns of 512 acres in November 1842 and began with wild land and a log house, and had no neighbors within two miles. Mr. Thayer married Diana Young of La Prairie, Wisconsin, June 22, 1841, who died Oct. 16, 1866, leaving seven children - Freeman, Ellen, Joseph, Louise, Alice, Joshua and Matie, the last two being twins, and all were born in the old homestead in Palmyra. Mr. Thayer married Mrs. Martha E. Morse of Lake Mills, Wis., Feb. 6, 1867. He is one of the successful pioneers who, by remaining on his first location, has made a home and competence for himself and family. His income tax in 1863 was the largest in Jefferson County. He is now breeding Merino sheep, Holstein cattle, horses, hogs, etc. Mr. Thayer is a staunch Republican and has been a Supervisor and Assessor in Palmyra, and is in sympathy with the Universalist Church."

A Territorial Map at the Watertown Octagon House

Museum, Watertown, Wis., shows only "Joshua Thayer" designating this acreage, as it was before Wisconsin became a State. In 1850 brick was hauled from

Milwaukee by oxen (50 miles) to replace the old log house, the experienced brickman being paid \$14 per month. The house burned in 1899 and was rebuilt with the same brick.

Charles Thayer (9th Generation) family built roads and developed vast acreage of marsh (original land contracts signed by Pres. Polk) adjacent to the old homestead.

Joshua⁷ Thayer (Joshua^{6,5}, Zachariah⁴, Nathaniel³, Richard^{2,1}).

One of the first settlers in Southern Wisconsin, building a small log cabin on 512 acres between Palmyra & Whitewater, Wisconsin in 1842, choosing the site because of the flowing well water. By remaining on his original land he became a successful pioneer, breeding Marino sheep and Holstein cattle. He & his family had ~~sheep~~ and cattle driven across country, losing the entire herd on one long trek from foot rot. He joined a group in the Gold Rush days heading for the "West", turning back at Pike's Peak.

In 1850 he erected what was then one of the finest brick houses in the county, the brick being hauled by ox team from Milwaukee.

Indians were often curious visitors, seeking salt, spices, flour, and tobacco.
