The Thaxton Reunion

The Eleventh Annual Thaxton Reunion will be held at Thaxton, Warren county, Tennessee, Sunday, June 20, 1937, from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The reunion will be held on the lawn of the Mt. Zion Methodist Church, South.

Thaxton, Tenn., formerly a post office, is located nine miles south of Mc-Minnville, and four miles northeast of Viola. The early settlers assisted in establishing the Mt. Zion Methodist church there, and the ground on which the reunion will be held was used by them as a place of worship. In the old Cope cemetery, one-half mile north, John Thaxton and others of his family are buried. Just across the road from the reunion scene is the Mt. Zion cemetery, where more than 100 Thaxtons are buried.

This occasion will not only be a reunion but a Thaxton homecoming. Those attending this reunion will be among the scenes of their pioneer ancestors, and many to the scenes of their younger days. At noon a sumptuous dinner will be served under the giant oaks. The dinner for this occasion is furnished by the Thaxtons residing within 150 miles of the reunion scene. Those living a greater distance are their dinner guests. All persons who are descendants of the early Thaxton settlers in Warren county, together with their wives and husbands, are invited and urged to attend. This is the first reunion at this place, and we want you and your entire family to join the Thaxton family circle on that day for the most enjoyable event of your lives.

The Thaxton Family History

For more than three years, W. G. McDonough of McMinnville, Tenn., has been making an effort to compile a history of the Thaxton family. He has written hundreds of letters, spent much time, money and energy to bring up to date and a complete record of the family. Letters have been written to Thaxtons all over the nation seeking information with reference to the various branches of the family. Quite a few have cooperated to the fullest extent, some have furnished only a part of the information requested and others have ignored these requests.

If you would like to see a complete history of the Thaxton family, your fullest cooperation will be necessary. Get out the old family Bible, old family records and write your relatives, and when the necessary information is obtained, ferward it, at once, to W. G. McDonough, McMinnville, Tenn. Furnish the information from as far back as is possible for you to go and bring it on up to date. The information should contain the following of each generation of your family: The name, date and place of birth; to whom married, date and place; various places and dates of residence and business, profession or occupation; date of death and place of burial; and names of children and dates of birth. Use this manner in bringing your branch of your family up to date, and when this is done there will be a complete history of the Thaxton family.

Brief Sketch of The Thaxton Family

The name Thaxton is of early English origin. From the records in London, England, it appears that the family, prior to the seventeenth century, resided in the counties of York and Norfolk England. The name is frequently spelled in the old English records as, Thekeston, Thexton, and Thackston. The record of the College of Arms, London, shows that on the 21st day of February 1857, the following arms, "Ermine a fretper pale gules and azure," were entered to one Richard Thekeston of Thekeston in the Wapentake of Halykeld, Richmond county, York, England. There is also found on the records attributing the following arms to the family of Thackston or Thexton of Trunch in the county of Norfolk, England, "Quarterly first and fourth, a cross between four lions' heads erased gules, second and third, Ermine fretty azure." One Lancelot Thackston, Chaplain to King Edward VI of England, who died in 1588, was apparently a member of this latter branch. It is more than likely that the Thaxton or Thackston family in America are descendants of the latter branch, however, it has not been definitely established to date, which of the two brancres is represented in this country. From the records now available, it appears that the Thaxtens from England settled in Virginia and North Carolina in early colonial days and their descendants may now be found in every state in the union. The most frequent ways of spelling the name in America are Thaxton or Thackston. It appears that all those of the early family in Virginia used the latter method while many in North Carolina used Thaxton. A search of the Revolutionary and other colonial war records in the United States reveals that the members of the Thaxton or Thackston family were loyal to the cause of American independence and other colonial conflicts.

Among the early settlers of Warren county, Tennessee, were John Thaxton. Thomas Thaxton and Rachael Thaxton. They settled in the southern part of the county nine miles south of McMinnville, soon after 1800, at a place which was later known as Thaxton. The relationship of these three people has not been determined, however, Thomas and Rachael Thaxton were either brother and sister of John Thaxton or his children, but more than likely the former.

Rachael Thaxton was born February 15, 1789 and married Alexander Johnston, jr., of Warren county, Tennessee, December 26, 1811, and died there August 30, 1812, upon the birth of her son, John Benoni Thaxton Johnston. This son, about 1817, left Warren county with his father and went to Missouri, where he now has a number of descendants. One descendant, Lt. Col. Rea A. Johnston, resides at Booneville, Mo.

Thomas Thaxton was born April 21, 1796, and married Sara Boyd Barnett of Warren county, May 10, 1814. Their children were: Robert Carroll Thaxton, born March 1, 1815, died May 28, 1897; James Barnett Thaxton, born March 16, 1818; Nancy Dillard Thaxton, born Oct. 1, 1820; Hily Ann Thaxton, born July 12, 1823; Martha Caroline Thaxton, born Dec. 16, 1825; William Thaxton, born Sept. 15, 1827; Margaret Evaline Thaxton, born March 1, 1833; Louisa Elizabeth Thaxton, born Sept. 9, 1835; and Rachael Jane Thaxton, born July 22, 1842. Thomas Thaxton died in Texas August 8, 1869 and his wife, Sara Boyd Barnett Thaxton died Aug. 21, 1877. A number of descendants of Thomas

Thaxton now reside in Texas and elsewhere. One of them, Hon. Lamar Thaxton of Mason, Texas, is District Judge.


Robert Carroll Thaxton and Louisa Bradley Rutherford were married March 14, 1844. Their childen were: Thomas Benjamin Thaxton, born Jan. 4, 1845 and died March 7, 1817; James Clinton Thaxton, born Dec. 7, 1846, died about 1920; Sara Jane Thaxton, born Sept. 30, 1848, died April 28, 1928; William Augustus Thaxton, born Sept. 10, 1850, died Sept. 14, 1866; Margaret Elizabeth Thaxton, born Aug. 20, 1852, died Dec. 27, 1896; Robert Calvin Thaxton, born April 15, 1854, died Oct. 10, 1928; Joseph Rufus Thaxton, born Dec. 12, 1855, died Sept. 8, 1896; John Barnett Thaxton, born Nov. 11, 1858, died May 11, 1920; Henderson Wise Thaxton, born Dec. 3, 1860, died Dec. 3, 1922; and Mary Louisa Thaxton, born March 26, 1863, died April 11, 1863.

Robert Calvin Thaxton, son of Robert Carroll and Louisa Rutherford Thaxton, and Emily Esther Mogford, were married December, 1886. Their children were: Judge Lamar Thaxton, born February 10, 1888; Harold Thaxton, born Oct. 31, 1889; Ruth Thaxton; Robert Calvin Thaxton; William Mogford Thaxton; Grace Thaxton and Sara Louise Thaxton. All are living with the exception of Grace Tlaxton, who died at the age of three years.

Judge Lamar Thaxton of Mason, Texas, now District Judge, and Ora Kathcrine Matern were married Feb. 7, 1917. Their children are: Mary Ellen Thaxton, born July 26, 1921; Calvin Lamar Thaxton, born June 25, 1923; and Gertrude Victoria Thaxton, born July 7, 1822.

Themas and Sara Boyd Barnett Thaxton are buried at Round Rock, Williamson county, Texas. Robert Carroll and Louisa Rutherford Thaxton, and daughters, Sara, Margaret, and Louisa, and son, William, are buried in Bagdad cemetery, near Leander, Williamson county, Texas.

John Thaxton, the third of the above mentioned pioneer settlers of Warren county, Tennessee, and from whom all the Thaxtons now living in Tennessee and many other states are descended, settled on a tract of land near the little village later known as Thaxton. Here he lived, reared his family, died and is buried. The log cabin which he erected has been gone a number of years. The little cemetery in which he is buried was abandoned many years ago and no grave stone now marks the last resting place of this stalwart pioneer settler. His children and grandchildren, who knew the location of his grave, have passed on and no cne is left to point out its location and give other information relative to his parents, brothers and sisters. So far, no record is available as to the date and place of birth, to whom and date of marriage, and the date of his death. The county records show in 1835 that he was then living but was a man aged and infirm. It is thought, from what records which can be obtained, that his father was also named John and that Thomas Thaxton and Rachael Thaxton were his brother and sister. No doubt, there were several other brothers and sisters, but so far as is known, no record is available with reference to them. The census of 1820 gives John Thaxton, then over 45 years of age, as a citizen of Warren county, Tennessee, and his family consisted of his wife, four daughters and four sons. His known children were as follows: Hiley, born June 3, 1803, died Nov. 16, 1882; John, jr., born April 26, 1805, died April 28, 1890; Cynthia Caroline, born Sept. 18, 1819, died March 4, 1858; Lucinda, born 1817, died 1888; and Wilburn, whose date of birth and death has not been obtained for the records. In addition to these, the records do not disclose the name of one other daughter and two sons of John Thaxton. It is known, however, that one daughter, whose name has not been obtained, married an Allison, a brother of James Allison, sr., and went to Texas where she lived and died. Two of her descendants, Misses Mollie and Laura Allison, live in Austin, Texas. Another son, whose name is thought to have been Martin, went to some southern state when a young man and nothing further was heard of him. The other son, whose name is not known, probably

went west when a young man and it is thought that he has descendants at Henrietta, Texas.

Hiley Thaxton was first married to Eisha Reynolds and upon his death Married John Morrow. Her children were, John Wesley Thaxton, E. K. P. Reynolds, James Morrow, Robert Morrow and Mary Morrow. James LaFayette Thaxton, merchant, large landowner and former postmaster at Thaxton, Tenn., was the son of John Wesley Thaxton. He was born July 24, 1846 and died May 14, 1920. His first wife was Mary McDonough, who was born Jan. 7, 1866 and died Aug. 13, 1890.

John Thaxton, jr., eldest son of John Thaxton, and Frances Hammons, daughter of Houston Hammons of Thaxton, were married Nov. 9, 1824. She died Jan. 18, 1887. From early childhood and until their death, both were active in the work of the Mt. Zion Methodist church at Thaxton and all their children were members of that church. Their children, all cf whom were born at Thaxton, were: James; William; Benjomin; Kelly; Thomas; Joiner; Rebecca, who married John Northcutt; Martha, who married Greek Brawley; Sarah, who married Dr. Fred Bell; Mary, who married Whitfield Jackson Humble, and after his death, Frances Marion McDonough; and Francis, who married James Hixson, and afterwards, Abner Deakins. The children of Mary Thaxton-Humble-McDonough, were as follows:

Two sons by her first marriage, William Joiner Humble, moved to South Pittsburg, Tenn., where he was in business, died in 1919, and John Walker Humble, died in Milwaukee, Wis., where he was an engineer on the Milwaukee railroad for a number of years. There were three children by her second marriage, James Francis McDonough, born March 5, 1867, and married Martha Sain, daughter of Thomas Sain of Sainville, Tenn., and now live at Viola, Tenn.; Mary Elizabeth, who married James LaFayette Thaxton, as shown above; and Samuel, who died at the age of about three years.

Wilburn Thaxton was first married to a Miss Comer, sister of the late Rev. A. L. Comer, pioneer Methodist minister of Warren county, and died upon the birth of her first hild. Both mother and child are buried in the old Cope cemetery near Thaxton. His second marriage was to Susie Hash of Rock Island, Tenn. His children by this marriage were: Dr. Montgomery Campbell Thaxton; Elisha Carter Thaxton; Ewing Thaxton; Callie Thaxtin, who married. John Boyd; Laura Thaxtnn, who married William Thomas Rodgers; Mary Thaxton, who married Howard Hudson; Euphrates Thaxton, who married John Harding; Adaline Thaxton, who married a Stroud; and Melvina Thaxton, who married a Chisam. Wilburn Thaxton made his home near Campaign, Warren. iounty, Tennessee until later in life, when he and his wife went to Thaxton, Miss., where they resided with their son, Dr. Montgomery G. Thaxton. They are both buried in the cemetery there. Thaxton, Miss., was named for Dr. Thaxton. Many of the descendants of Wilburn Thaxton are found in various parts. of the nation and have played a prominent part in the professional, business and religious life of their respective communites.


Cynthia Caroline Thaxton married James Allison, sr., of Thaxton, Tenn., Both are buried in the Mt. Zion cemetery. Their children were: James F. Bunyan, William, Clementine, who married Aarch Pepper, and afterwards, Joe Talley; Cynthia, who married a Mr. Pepper; Anderson; Sirena, who married E. C. Pepper; Amanda, who married R. L. Talley; and John. All are dead with the exception of James F., the only living grandchild of John Thaxton, sr., and lives at Vervilla, near Morrison, Tenn.

Lucinda Thaxton married Wilburn Blanks. They resided near Increase,. Warren county, Tenn., and are buried in the Shiloh cemetery near Campaign.. Both were active in the affairs of the Methodist church of their community.

Their children were: John S. B.; Monroe; Henry; Reams; and Mary, who married a Pearson. All the above are dead but their children may be found in several states. Lucinda Thaxton was born at Thaxton, Tenn., but after her marriage to Wilburn Blanks, their home was near Increase until their death.


Due to the fact that space for this article is limited and expensive, very little has been written about the Thaxtons of the present day. Since it is very difficult, at times, to get information from those living with reference to the present members of their family this space has been devoted largely to the early settlers for the benefit of those who are not familiar with the early family history in this country. It is the sincere hope of the writer that this pamphlet may create more interest in the Thaxton family history and those receiving a copy may get busy and render the necessary cooperation in order that a complete history may be written and published at an early date. It is the desire on our part that the numerous members of the family, without being requested, will collect the necessary information and forward it to the author as soon as possible.

The following pages contain the names and addresses of all the known living descendants of the Thaxton pioneer settlers in Warren County, Tennessee. Some, whose names we have, may have been left out by an oversight. It will be noted in some instances, a large number of the same family are listed at the same address in some of the cities, which is due to the fact that the street addresses have not all been furnished, and those of the same family living in the same city are listed at the same address of other members of the family. All these names, with but few exceptions, are the direct descendants of John Thaxton, sr., pioneer settler of Warren county, Tenn. The descendants of Thomas Thaxton and Rachael Thaxton have been omitted due to the fact that they are far from complete.
