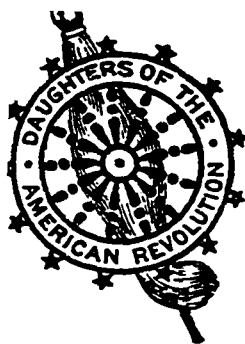

Whiting's Regt., Apr. 2, 1759 to Dec. 2, 1759. He served as private in the Revolutionary War in Capt. S. Hurlburt's Co., 4th^B Brigade, Conn. Line, roll of May 1, 1778. He was a communicant and warden of the Episcopal Church at Davies' Hollow, now called Romford. He was in Ferrisburg as early as 1802.

In 1800, William Lyon and his family were residents of Bethlehem, Conn., also a part of Ancient Woodbury and adjacent to Washington. By 1810 they had left there but it is not known to what place they removed. By 1813 the family were in Wayne Co., N.Y. Sarah Lyon was one of the charter members of the old Free Will Baptist Church near Walworth, N.Y. The only son and apparently the only child, Daniel Lyon, was appointed administrator of William Lyon's estate in Sept., 1823. The records of the estate aside from the letters of administration have been lost. After William Lyon's death, his widow lived for a time with her grandsons, Newton and Edwin Lyon, but later she lived in Ontario where she died.

Lucius Titus is said to have been a cousin of his wife and to have moved to Coldwater, Mich. The Titus Foundry in that city was founded by the family of Thurlow Titus in 1854 and Lucius may have been his father or other relative.

Samuel Walter Titus came to Michigan in 1867. He was prominent in the Baptist denomination and was the founder of the B.Y.P.U. From 1878 to 1886 he was pastor of the 12th Street Baptist Church, Detroit.

Daniel Lyon served as a private in the War of 1812 in the same regiment and company with his future brother-in-law, Samuel Strickland, enlisting under Capt. Gilbert Hinkley of the 39th Regt. N.Y. Militia, June 20, 1813 and giving four days service in the vicinity of his home. This service has been accepted by the United States Daughters of 1812. Daniel Lyon was the first clerk of the Free Will Baptist Church near Walworth, known as the "Old Stone Church" of which his mother was a charter member. The early records of the church in his handwriting are still in existence and are carefully preserved in the vaults of the Rochester Theological Seminary. In 1824 he was ordained to be the first resident pastor of this church and continued in this position until his death. The sermon preached at his funeral was from the text, "Help, Lord, for the godly man ceaseth." His epitaph reads,
 "Rest, faithful servant, companion, and child.
 In life thou wast pleasant, in death thou
 didst smile.

Thy flock thou hast left, while thy friends weep
 around,

To rest in the tomb till the trumpet shall
 sound."

The picture of the life in that pioneer settlement, as described in the church records of his keeping, is most vivid and demonstrates the stern virtues and outlook on existence which were brought from the earlier New England home. Elder Lyon was a tenant farmer, for in those days the preachers gave their services to the Lord, and earned their livelihood in other ways. Therefore it was considered a radical innovation when it was decided to pay him a salary of \$100.00 a year. After his death, his widow received a pension from the old church and donation parties from the members. She was an invalid from the birth of her child till her death.

No children. Dr. Lyon holds his Ph.D. degree from the University of Chicago, and has several honorary degrees from other institutions. He acted as biologist for the Cook Greenland expedition in 1894 and has held many important teaching positions.
