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FOREWORD

Among the early settlers of New Netherlands (New Amsterdam, now New York City) were Jan Otto Van Tuyl, who with a wife and child, arrived from Holland on the De Bonte Koe, (Spotted Cow) on April 16, 1663. They settled in New York City where it is reported they lived along the "Wall". Their children were christened in the Reformed Dutch Church of New York City. The youngest of these, the twins Isaac and Abraham, later acquired land on the northern part of Staten Island. Descendants of this family group have now spread far and wide over the United States.

The name Van Tuyl comes from the noble manor of Tuyl in the district of Tiel of the province of Gelderland in Holland. Van or van like von in the German language means "of" or "of the house of". The first record of the use of the name was by Hugo, Lord of Tuyl, knight, in 1125. However, the uninterrupted descent of this family in Holland is from a knight by the name of Gysbert Van Tuyll who died in 1343.

By royal decree of March 31, April 25 and May 7, 1822, all legitimate Van Tuyls of Holland, bear the title and style themselves baron or baroness.

In an effort to determine whether the Van Tuyls of America are descendants of the Dutch of the same name, an inquiry was addressed to a Baron Van Tuyl of The Hague prior to 1940. After a delay of several months, a courteous reply advised that his genealogist had been unable to find any connection between the Dutch and American Van Tuyls. However, further research on this subject is recommended.

Van Tuyls in Early Wars and The Revolution

During the colonial engagements with the Indians, certain Van Tuyls are known to have been involved. One of them received an award for gallantry in action. It is assumed that one or more of them also served in the French and Indian War. But their greatest contribution was in the Revolutionary War, when at least fifteen Van Tuyls entered the army, four of these from Somerset County, N.J. They served in the New Jersey militia under Captain John Sebring. One was an ensign (equivalent to second lieutenant), one a corporal and the others were privates. Morris County, N.J., contributed an ensign and Hunterdon County, of the same state, two service men, presumably privates. New York State supplied five service men. One is known to have been a first lieutenant and one an ensign.

Van Tuyls are known to have been in the armed service during the War of 1812, one of whom was a lieutenant and one a captain. The part played by members of the family in the later wars of the United States has not been compiled.

Near the close of the Revolutionary War the Legislature of the state of New York passed an Act setting aside approximately 1,680,000 acres of undeveloped land in the western portion of the state as bounty land to be awarded to privates and non-commissioned officers, who had served in the army for a certain period. The area embraced the present counties of Onondaga, Cayuga, Seneca, and Cortland; the greater part of Tompkins, and smaller parts

of Oswego and Wayne Counties. A later Act (1789) provided for a survey of the tract and the award of a lot, consisting of 600 acres, to each veteran with sufficient service to qualify. Unfortunately, many sold their lots at ridiculously low prices. Nevertheless, there was a substantial migration of pioneers to the newly opened country and thousands of farms and many villages, towns and cities were founded. Among the early settlers were numerous Van Tuyls from Somerset County, New Jersey, who favored Seneca County.

Members of this family eventually spread from New Jersey and New York into more than fifteen additional states, including; Connecticut, Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Ohio, Michigan, Illinois, Iowa, Missouri, Nebraska, Colorado, Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, California, Washington, and The District of Columbia.

Vocations Followed

As was the case of most early settlers in the United States, farming and ranching were the vocations followed by the majority of the heads of families. Two Van Tuyls operated, at different times, a ferry between Staten Island and Manhattan. One of them lost his life as a result of the sinking of his craft. In later years, several Van Tuyls became physicians. Other means of livelihood were dealing in real estate; finance; road commissioners; peace officers; carpenters; educators; engineers; officers and privates in the armed forces; developers of vineyards; a minister of the gospel; and one was a member of the legislature of New York State. An unusual profession was that of piracy: a son of Jan Otto Van Tuyl, by the name of Otto, after considerable experience as a member of the crew of the notorious Captain Kidd, entered this profession with his own ship of 130 tons and a crew of 145 men. However, a fortunate act of nature was to save the family name from disrepute. Soon after the start of his operation, his ship was wrecked on Sandy Hook during a violent storm, in the dead of winter. Otto and all members of his crew except thirteen were lost.

The primary purpose of the following contributions to Van Tuyl genealogy is to make available information assembled from many sources in addition to that contained in "Notes on the Van Tuyl Family" compiled in 1959. Information has been obtained not only from official State and County sources but from many individuals who provided data from family Bibles, cemetery and church records and from personal knowledge of their immediate families and close relatives.
