PREFACE

This history is a preliminary study of JOHN WAGLE, his wife, JEMIMA TODD, and their descendants.

John Wagle was the son of John and Mary Wagle, of Pennsylvania. One chapter is devoted to a brief notice of their family, included for reference only, and without any attempt to present their history. One chapter also deals with the ancestry of Jemima Todd Wagle.

This work is published as a means of furthering the work of any person engaged in genealogical research on the Wagle name. It does not represent complete research into all available sources, but since fairly comprehensive records have been accumulated in connection with certain lines of the family, it is believed desirable to release such information pending the time a more exhaustive search can be undertaken.

Any person now developing a genealogy of the entire Wagle Family is invited to correspond with the compiler, and is free to use any or all of the data herein, provided credit is acknowledged. If members of the family note discrepancies or can add to this record, the facts should be communicated to the compiler.

JOHN WAGLE'S PARENTS

The parents of John Wagle, subject of this history, were John and Mary Wagle, of Pennsylvania.

They are believed to be the John and Mary Wagle who lived at Easton, Pennslyvania, of whom the following records exist:-

Johann Adam Wegel is shown on the list of passengers ("foreigners") imported in the ship "Phoenix," William Wilson, Captain, which sailed from Rotterdam and arrived in Philadelphia in October, 1744.

On September 24, 1754, John Wagle made known his allegience to Pennsylvania and to the British Crown, and is shown as a resident of Northampton Company, Pennslyvania. According to the terms of the law, it was not necessary for a person of a dissenting religious faith to be sworn; John Wagle availed himself of this exception which respected conscientious scruples against oaths and vows, and may thus have been a Moravian, as were most of the settlers of Easton, Pennsylvania. Persons affirming their allegience, or becoming subjects, must under the law have lived in the colonies for at least seven years, and not have been away for more than two months at any time during this period. This would have placed the entry of our John Wagle early enough to have been the Johann Adam Wegel shown in the reference just above.

During March of the year in which he became a British Subject, John Wagle had purchased land in Easton, Northampton County, from the Penn brothers, Thomas and Richard. This land he sold in 1765, as evidenced by the deed abstract following:-

THIS INDENTURE TRIPARTITE MADE THE 9TH DAY OF JANUARY 5TH YR GEORGE 111, YEAR OF OUR LORD 1765, BETWEEN JOHN WAGLE OF EASTON IN THE COUNTY OF NORTHAMPTON IN THE PROVINCE OF PENNSYLVANIA YEOMAN AND MARY HIS WIFE ------WHEREAS IN AND BY A CERTAIN INDENTURE MADE THE FOURTEENTH DAY OF MARCH ANNO DOMINI 1754 BETWEEN THE HON. THOMAS PENN AND RICHARD PENN ESQUIRES OF THE ONE PART AND THE SAID JOHN WAGLE (BY THE NAME OF JOHN WAGELL) OF THE OTHER PART THEY THE SAID THOMAS PENN AND RICHARD PENN (RECITING AS IS THEREIN RE-CITED) DID GIVE GRANT AND CONFIRM UNTO THE SAID JOHN WAGLE A CERTAIN LOT OF GROUND SITUATE IN EASTON AFORSAID CONTAINING IN BREADTH NORTH AND SOUTH 55 FEET AND IN LENGTH 240 FEET BOUNDED BY POMPHRET, ETC. - BETWEEN LOTS 142 AND 144 --- LAND NOW CONVEYED TO JOHN REES.

(Note the name of John's wife, Mary, in the above.)

During John Wagle's Easton residence, the earlier settlers had protested "To the worshipful the Justices of the Ct. of Easton, Northampton," against the settlement of Catholics in their midst. The fifth name on the petition, which was dated June 18th, 1755, was John Wagle.

No further record of John Wagle appears in Easton, however, in 1765a John Wagle arrived in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. Since this the year our ancestor John Wagle sold his Easton lot, this John at Greensburg may also prove to have been our ancestor. Further, descendants of the Westmoreland John Wagle claimed in 1890 that their ancestor John came from Easton, but gave Christina Johnston as the name of his wife, rather than Mary.

In 1783, the Westmoreland John Wagle died, leaving a will which is recorded as follows:

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN, I JOHN WAGLE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HEMPFIELD IN THE COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA BEING ADVANCED IN YEARS AND CONSEQUENTLY DRAWING ON TOWARDS MY END IN THIS WORLD AND ALSO BEING THROUGH THE GOODNESS OF GOD OF SOUND MEMORY AND JUDGEMENT THEREFORE CALLING TO MIND THE MORTALITY OF MY BODY AND THAT IT IS APPOINTED FOR ALL MEN TO DIE DO IN THIS FIRST DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY THREE MAKE AND ORDAIN THIS MY LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, AND DESIGRES IT MAY BE RECEIVED AS SUCH BY ALL. THAT IS TO SAY PRINCIPALLY AND FIRST OF ALL I GIVE AND BEQUEATH MY SOUL TO ALMIGHTY GOD WHO GAVE IT TO ME AND MY BODY TO BE DECENTLY BURIED AT THE DISCRETION OF MY EXECUTOR HEREAFTER NAMED AND AS TOUGHING SUCH WORLDLY ESTATE AS IT HAS PLEASED GOD TO BLESS ME WITH IN THIS LIFE I GIVE AND DISPOSE OF THE SAME IN MANNER AND FORM FOLLOWING VIZ. ALL MY DEBTS WHICH OF RIGHT I DO OWE TO ANY PERSON I DO ORDER TO BE PUNCTUALLY PAID. IMPRIMUS ALL MY GOODS AND CHATTELS WHICH I OWN AND POSSESS AT THE TIME OF MY DECEASE I DO ORDER TO BE SOLD ACCORDING TO LAW AND THE MONEY ARISING THEREFROM WITH WHAT CASH OR MONEY I MAY HAVE IN HAND OR DUE TO ME FROM ANY PERSON OR PERSONS TO BE PAID AS FOLLOWING. TO MY OLDEST SON JOHN FIVE SHILLINGS LAWFUL MONEY OF PENNSYLVANIA WHICH I DO ORDER TO BE PAID TO HIM ON DEMAND AFTER MY DECEASE SBY MY EXECUTOR AS HIS FULL SHARE HE HAVING RECEIVED A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY IN GOLD SOME TIME PAST FOR HIS FULL PART THAT I EVER INTENDED FOR HIM, AND ALSO SEVEN POUNDS LAWFUL MONEY OF PENNSYLVANIA TO MY DAUGHTER ELIZABETH WAGLE TO BE PAID UNTO HER IN ONE YEAR AFTER MY DECEASE IS DOF MARRYED, BUT IN CASE SHE BE DEAD OR SHOULD DIE BEFORE SHE IS OF AGE AND UNMARRYED THEN AND IN THAT CASE I DO ORDER THE SAME SEVEN POUNDS TO BE DIVIDED AMONGST MY FOUR CHILDREN EQUALLY AND I FURTHER DO ORDER THAT ALL THE MONEY THAT IS OVER AND ABOVE THE ABOVE MENTIONED SUMS TO BE GOUALLY THE DIVIED AMONST MY FOUR CHILDREN SARAH SMITH ABRAHAM ISAAC AND JACOB WA

JOHN WAGLE

SIGNED SEALED PRONOUNCED AND DECLARED BY ME THE SAID JOHN WAGLE AS HIS LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT IN THE PRESENCE OF US ANTONEY ALTMAN, CHRISTIAN BONN, PHILIP ALTMAN.

PROVED JANY, 15TH, 1803 AND RECORDED

Please note that I can offer no proof that the John Wagle of the foregoing instrument is identical with our John (I) of Easton. However the following points are suggested for speculation:-

Our John Wagle (II) had a Jacob Wagle, probably his brother, living with him in Kentucky, who appears in tax lists of Madison County, Kentucky, in 1792 and through 1796. Note that the above John had sons John and Jacob neither of whom raised families in Westmoreland County, although his other children are mentioned frequently in records of Old Zion's and Brush Creek Churchs, both in Westmoreland County, and in various county records.

Children of the Westmoreland County John Wagle were:-

John (possibly our ancester, John II) Elizabeth Sarah - married Michael Schmidt Abraham - married Maria Christina Brinich Isaac - married Maria Catherina Keppel Jacob (possibly our relative Jacob, of Kentucky)

JEMIMA TODD'S PARENTS

Jemima Todd, wife of John Wagle (II) was the daughter of Thomas and Elizabeth Todd, of Pennsylvania and North Carolina.

Thomas Todd died in 1777, by tradition the victim of wounds received as a Revolutionary soldier. A statement from the Adjutant General's office, United States War Department, reads: "The records of this office show that Thomas Todd served in the Revolutionary War as a musician in McGlauhan's Company, 7th North Carolina Regiment. He enlisted ______, 1777, for three years, and died September ______, 1777. No further record relative to him or to his service has been found." This record is also found in North Carolina State Records, and an entry showing that a Mr. Philip Fishburn received pay (?as attorney?) in 1786, L 38.8.6 for the service of Thomas Todd.

Thomas Todd had earlier served in the North Carolina troops under Captain Lawrence Thompson, enlisting May 1st, 1771 and serving until June 29th. He was paid for sixty days at 7s6d, or £ 6.0.0.

While no definite record of our Thomas Todd has been found in Pennsylvania, all branches of the family carry the tradition of his birth either in England or Pennsylvania, as well as residence in Pennsylvania prior to settling in Rowan County, North Carolina. In Rowan County we find another Todd family, headed by Caleb Todd, Sr., which originated in Easton, Pennsylvania -home of our Wagles, and which migrated in a body to

Madison County, Kentucky at the same time as Thomas Todd's children and the Wagles and Coxes. Caleb was probably the brother of our Thomas, and the records of his children's pension claims for Revolutionary War activities provide a clue to the Pennsylvania home of our Thomas and Elizabeth Todd.

Thomas Todd's will, probated in Røwan County, North Carolina in 1777, names his wife Elizabeth and the children noted below:

Joseph Todd (b. circa 1748, married Ann Crose in Pennsylvania, moved from Rowan County, North Carolina, to Madison County, Kentucky, where he died in 1812.)

Thomas Todd (married Jean Simonton, and moved from Rowan County, North Carolina, prior to 1790. Was probably one of the three Thomas Todds in Madison County, Kentucky, 1785.)

Elizabeth Cox (believed to be wife of Benjamin Cox, father of Jesse who married Mary Wagle.)

Hester Lewis Sarah Todd Jemima Todd (wife of John Wagle)

JOHN WAGLE (II) AND JEMIMA TODD

John Wagle was born October 9, 1751 at Easton, Northhampton County, Pennsylvania. The date of his birth he recorded in a Family Bible in which he also entered the births, deaths, and marriages of his wife, his children, and many of his grandchildren. The flyleaf of this Bible is inscribed "John Wagle His Book June Ye 14, 1807." The Book bears imprint of its publisher, Matthew Carey, Philadelphia, 1805. His birth entry reads "John Wagle the son of John Wagle and Mary his wife was born the ninth day of October old stile in the year 1751."

John moved to North Carolina (Note:-one source says he was born in North Carolina) where he is claimed to have served three years as a Lieutenant of the North Carolina Line, serving under a Captain Hedrick "in an engagement against the Tories on the Pee Dee River." The family mustered affidavits of this service from North Carolina neighbors, but in spite of extensive court attendance, etc., proof of service was never accepted by the pension authorities.

Rowan County, North Carolina, appears to have been John Wagle's home, for it was here he married Jemima Todd, on 26 March, 1778. Jemima, daughter of Thomas Todd and wife Elizabeth, was born January 19, 1759, probably in Pennsylvania.

This family moved to Kentucky in 1790 or 1791. In 1792, both John and Jacob "Wegel" are listed as landowners in the Madison County Tax Lists. Here John 's family settled and were slaveowners, making their home on Otter Creek and at Foxtown (now Whitehall) just north of Richmond, Kentucky, on the Richmond-Lexington Turnpike. John Wagle died in Madison County on July 28, 1818; Jemima Todd Wagle survived him, dying April 30, 1850, at the home of her son Thomas Wagle. Their children are:-

2 - MARY WAGLE COX

Mary Wagle was born 3 July, 1781, in Rowan County, North Carolina, and died 1851 or 1852, near Whitehall, Madison County, Kentucky. She married, on December 16, 1803, Jesse Cox, in Madison County.

Jesse Cox, son of Benjamin Cox (born in South Carolina, lived North Carolina and Kentucky - Revolutionary Soldier, companion of Squire Boone, and Ohio Pioneer, buried in Dayton, Ohio) was born in Rowan County, North Carolina, in 1780, and died in the spring of 1861, in Madison County.

The compiler is descended through this line, and is prepared to furnish details of later generations not appropriate for inclusion in this History.

2A JOHN COX

John Cox, wheelwright, was born 19 October, 1804, Whitehall, Madison County, Kentucky. He married March 1, 1827, in Madison, Mary (or "Permelia") Parks, daughter of John. She was born in Madison in 1807. Both lived after 1870. Children (all born at Whitehall) were:-

2B GREENBERRY COX

Greenberry Cox (one source gives middle initial "L") was born December 27, 1806, at Whitehall (Foxtown) Madison County, Kentucky. He married Permelia Mallory, probably in Kentucky. Permelia was born 8 March, 1809, in Virginia, daughter of Ezekiel Mallory, who moved to Madison County, Kentucky and in old age lived in Putnam County, Indiana. Greenberry and Permelia Mallory Cox settled in Chariton County, Missouri, between 1850 and 1860, where both died, Greenberry on March 15, 1886, and Permelia on October 7, 1890. Both are buried in the "Hurt Graveyard," adjoining their old farm, outside Keytesville, Missouri.

2C EZEKIEL COX

Ezekiel Cox, born 8 May, 1809 in Madison County, Kentucky, was there married on March 29, 1833, to Elizabeth Martin, sister of Robert H. Martin and possibly daughter of Azariah Martin. She was born, 1811, in Madison County, and died in Howard County about 1866. Ezekiel Cox moved with his family to Howard County, settling near Armstrong, Mo., about 1839. He died near Armstrong on March 13, 1856.

2D MARTIN HARDIN COX

Martin Hardin Cox was born 18 January, 1812, in Madison County, Kentucky. He married, in that county, 1st, (12 May, 1832) Narcissus Riley, and 2nd (29 August, 1855) Elizabeth Rogers. He was a carpenter and farmer.

Narcissus Riley, daughter of William and Margaret Riley, was born October 15, 1813, in Madison, and died there in 1854, leaving five children listed below.

Elizabeth Rogers, the second wife, was born in Indiana in 1830, according to the 1880 census record; other records say in Kentucky. She was the daughter of Julius Rogers and wife Catherine Alcorn, of Madison County. Elizabeth Rogers Cox died in October, 1888, and is buried in Asberry Cemetery, Keytesville, Chariton County, Missouri. She left six children.

2E THOMAS WAGLE COX

Thomas Wagle Cox was born 14 August, 1814, in Madison County, Kentucky; on February 13, 1840, he married, in Estill County, Kentucky, Rhoda Gentry, daughter of David Gentry and wife, Jaley Ham,

Rhoda Gentry Cox was born March 31, 1819, in Madison County, and died December 7, 1897. She was buried in Red Hill Cemetery, at Panola, Kentucky, with her husband, whose death was November 21, 1885. Children of Thomas and Rhoda Cox:-

Isaac Cox, born January, 1817, in Madison County, Kentucky, married on October 12, 1844, Elizabeth Campbell. Silas Todd, probably a Campbell relative, was marriage bondsman. No further record of this couple appears in Madison.

2G ELIZABETH COX MARTIN

Elizabeth Cox was born November 13, 1819. She married, 28 April, 1840, in Madison County, Kentucky, Liberty B. Martin, son of the pioneer Azariah Martin. He was born in 1810, and lived on the South Fork of Station Camp Creek. Both lived after 1860. Children:-

2H JEMIMA COX SHIFFLETTE

Jemima Cox (note - named for Jemima Wagle, her grandmother) was born 8 November, 1822, Foxtown, Madison County, Kentucky, and died at Vandalia, Ohio, in 1881.

She married Hillory Shifflette, son of Fountain and Rebecca Shifflette, on June 27, 1843, in Madison County.

Hillory Shifflette was born in 1821, and was killed in the Battle of Mission Ridge (Tennessee) November 24, 1863.

3 - ISAAC WAGLE

Isaac Wagle, third child of John and Jemima Wagle, was born August 22, 1783.

On June 21, 1810, in Madison County, Kentucky, he married his cousin Phoebe Todd, daughter of Joseph Todd and Ann Crose, who was born about 1784 in Rowan County, North Carolina.

Isaac Wagle does not appear in the census records of Madison County after 1820. In that year, ten years after the marriage, he and his wife are shown with no children. His death date is given as April 3, 1841 in his father's Bible.

Phoebe Todd Wagle remarried; her marriage to John Hawkins, on October 28, 1841, is recorded in Madison County, Kentucky. It would thus appear that Isaac and his wife had lived with other members of the family, in Madison County, but had not maintained a separate household during the years before his death, although he was at one time owner of Madison County land.

The pension claim developed by John Wagle's children does not indicate that any children were born to Issac and Phoebe, confirming the census record before noted. Also, at the sale of his personal property upon his death, no children are recorded.

4 - JOHN WAGLE III

The desire of John and Jemima Wagle to perpetuate the name John Wagle is evidenced by the fact that their first son was named John, and after his death, their fourth child was also given the name.

John Wagle, Jr. (so called in his father's Bible) was born October 17, 1785, in Rowan County, North Carolina, and was not more than five years old when his parents removed to Madison County. Here he married Mary Owens, on November 4, 1806.

Mary Owens' relative, Cornelius Owens, was bondsman at the marriage. The names of her parents are not known to the compiler. She was born in North Carolina, in 1789, and died sometime after 1860 at the home of her son, Jeptha Wagle, at Arenzville, Cass County, Illinois.

The date and place of John Wagle's death are not known. The family moved sometime after 1830 to Brown County, Illinois, and it is presumed he died in that county.

Elizabeth Wagle, born July 15, 1809, Foxtown, Madison County, Kentucky, was married on May 21, 1828, in Madison County, to James H. Gentry. James was son of Brightberry Gentry and probably of his first wife, Martha Jones; he was born in 1809, in Madison County.

Although the Wagle Bible records his name as "Jonathan", this son of John and Mary Owens Wagle is generally found as Jeptha Wagle. He was born May 5, 1812, in Madison County, Kentucky, and died during December, 1860, at Arenzville, Cass County, Illinois.

Jeptha married his second cousin, Phoebe Todd (daughter of Isaac) in Madison County, Kentucky, on February 10, 1833, about the year in which his parents and family moved from the State. Phoebe was born in 1812, in Madison County, and died about 1890, at Beardstown, Cass County, Illinois.

The record of this family between 1833 and 1839 is obscure; certain census records give birth places of children born during this period as North Carolina. (Question:-Didthe family return to that State to participate in settlement of an estate?). In 1839, the family is again in Kentucky, and by 1841 is located in Illinois.

After the death of her sister, Julia Ann, Nancy R. Wagle became the second wife of John Frederick Unland (see above) in 1857, at Arenzville, Cass County, Illinois. Nancy was born in 1838 or 1839, perhaps in North Carolina. One child was:-

Isaac Todd Wagle was born in Madison County, Kentucky, May 6, 1839. Raised on a farm in Cass County, Illinois, he there married, on January 19, 1868, Jennie Davidson. Jennie, born in Ireland February 15, 1845, was probably the daughter of James and Elizabeth Davidson, both born in Ireland in 1800 and who came to Illinois after 1849.

8E HENRY C. WAGLE

Henry C. Wagle, son of Doctor Lewis Wagle and wife Charlotte Kelly, was born in 1840 or 1841, in Ohio. He grew up in Platte, County, Missouri, and lived with the Carrington family until his marriage, July 30, 1873, to Missouri Elizabeth Snider. Mrs. Wagle's death occurred sometime before that of her husband, who died September 8, 1920, in Platte County.

- 8E2 Carrie L. Wagle married a Mr. Merkel, and lived in Los Angeles, California.
- 8E3 Myra B. Wagle married in Platte County, Missouri, October 5, 1899, Charles A. Grady, of Edgerton, Missouri. One child, (8E31) Blanche Maurine Grady. Both the mother and child died before 1912.
- 8E4 Lewis E. Wagle died unmarried on April 4, 1912, in Platte County, Missouri.

UNPROVEN CONNECTIONS

The compiler has several fragmentary Wagle and Weigle records in his files, which he cannot relate positively to the family described in this book. Of these groups, only the following family is closely enough identified, both by geography and by similarity of given names, to be claimed even though the connection is unknown.

As a hypothesis, it is suggested the family might trace its descent through William A. Wagle, 4E2.

John Rahe Wagle, who died at Galesburg, Illinois, August 26, 1936, married Jeanette Lamb, who died at Galesburg on September 4, 1942. Two children were <u>Blanche Wagle</u>, (Mrs. William Stoke) and Lewis Samuel Wagle.

Lewis Samuel Wagle was born at Beardstown, Illinois, January 25, 1895, and died March 11, 1939, at Metuchen, N. J. He married Irene Frances Nelson on January 10, 1917, at Macomb, Illinois. Mrs. Wagle was born September 4, 1897, at Camp Point, Illinois, daughter of Marion and Margaret Nelson; she now lives at Fort Madison, Iowa. Their children:-
