

WALLINGFORD FAMILY RECORDS

Samuel B. Shackford

Nicholas Wallingford aged 9, a poor boy, servant of Stephen Kent came in the Confidence April 24, 1638. Lived Newbury. Bought Henry Travers farm Oct. 1, 1659. Removed to Bradford. Gave an acre of land for ministry. He was taken captive at sea and never returned. His estate was administered on in 1682. He married Sarah Travers 30 Aug. 1654 at Newbury. She was daughter of Henry and Bridget Travers (Peper Pioneers 476). He was admitted free-man ^{Oct} 116^d 1670 (Rec. Mass. Bay 4-584). His mother was sister of William Gore of Nether Wallop, Southampton England, who left legacies to Nicholas & Margaret son and daughter of late sister Wallingford.
