THE WHITCOMB FAMILY.

JOHN WHITCOMB¹ was probably a son of Symon Whitcomb, who was one of six "knights and gentlemen" to whom was granted, 19 March, 1627, that part of New England lying between the Merrimack and Charles Rivers. He was in Dorchester as early as 1633, and is supposed to have come from Dorsetshire, England. Removed to Scituate in 1640, and to Lancaster, Mass., in 1654, and, with his son John, was one of the original owners of that town. In 1646 he wrote his name Whetcombe.

He was born about 1588, and died at Lancaster, Mass., 24 September, 1662. His widow, Frances, who died 17 May, 1671, named in her will five sons and three daughters, whose dates or order of birth are unknown.

ASA WHITCOMB⁴ (John,³ Jonathan,² John¹), of Lancaster, Mass., was the famous Col. Asa Whitcomb of Revolutionary times. He commanded one of the continental regiments in the expedition to Crown Point and Ticonderoga. He represented Lancaster in "the greate and generale corte," 1766, 1768, 1769, 1770, 1771, 1772, 1773, 1774. At the commencement of the war he was one of the wealthiest citizens of Sterling. He was for many years entrusted with the most important and responsible positions. He was deacon of the church from 1760, and justice of the peace. While in the General Court he voted with Adams, Otis, and other Whigs, in the disputes with Gov. Hutchinson. He was a member of the County Convention held in Worcester in August, 1774, to consult on measures for defence and safety in that trying period. In May, 1775, he raised a regiment and was commissioned colonel.

In the re-organization of the army he was assigned to other duty, but his men refused to serve except under him; whereupon he volunteered to serve in the ranks, which, coming to the knowledge of Washington, he was re-instated by him. He commanded

at Prospect Hill during the siege of Boston, and, with Col. B. Lincoln, was soon after chosen muster-master of the Massachusetts troops. In 1776 he commanded a regiment ordered to Ticonderoga and Crown Point. Such was his zeal in the cause of liberty, and so great his confidence in the patriotism and integrity of his countrymen, that he pledged his whole fortune upon the faith of the paper currency, and consequently became bankrupt. He died in Princeton, Mass., 16 March, 1804, at the age of eighty-four.

THE PIERCE FAMILY.

Of the Pierce family, of which my mother was a descendant, my records date back only to 1740.

The spelling of the family name was changed from Peirce to Pierce a short time after the four brothers, Franklin, Abijah, Isaac, and Edwin, settled in western New York. The reason for the change was that the people insisted on writing the name ie instead of ei, and finally the brothers adopted the new way.
