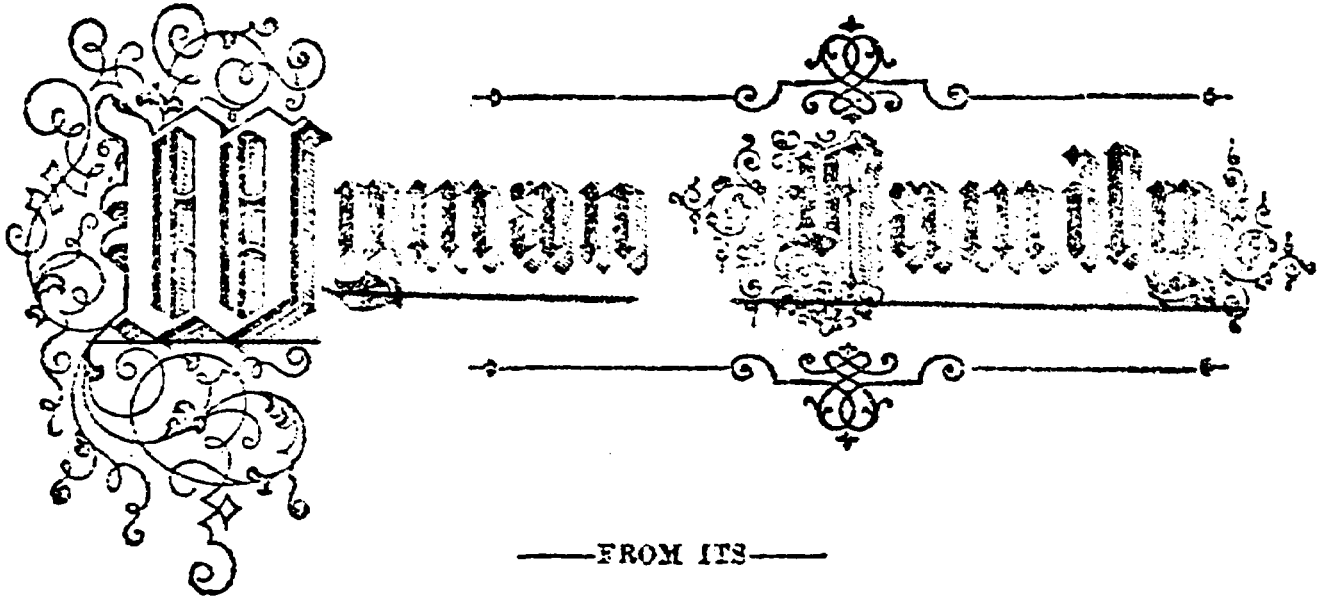

GENEALOGY OF THE WYMAN FAMILY.

Collected by T. B. Wyman, Jr., of Charlestown, Mass.

The name of Wyman is of German derivation, and was originally spelled Weymann. The two individuals first named in the following genealogy are the progenitors of the largest portion of the Wyman family in this country. The first mention made of them is in Charlestown, December 18th, 1640, (see Frothingham, p. 106,) as signers of the "town orders," coeval with the settlement of Woburn. Their descendants have been numerous, and chiefly among the "sturdy yeomanry," possessing substance and a fair estimation in the ordinary ranks of life. At the present time, the family is chiefly comprised in that class so ably apostrophized by the poet, in the thrilling lines:

"Heart of the people—Working men!
Marrow and nerve of human powers;
Who on your sturdy backs sustain
Through streaming time, this World of Ours."

FIRST GENERATION.

12. VIII—Jonathan, cornet, of Woburn, farmer, born July 13, 1661, married (see wives), died December 15, 1736. He married, first, Abigail, daughter of James Fowle, of Woburn, July 29, 1689, who died January 3, 1690; married second, Hannah, daughter of Peter Fowle, of Woburn, July 31, 1690.

13. IX—Seth, Lieut., of Woburn, farmer, born August 3, 1663, married December 17, 1685, died October 26, 1715. He married Hester, daughter of Wm. Johnson, of Woburn, December 17, 1685, who died March 31, 1742.

14. X—Jacob, of Woburn, tanner, born——, married (see wives), died March 31, 1742. He married, first,

Elizabeth, daughter of Samuel Richardson, of Woburn, November 23, 1687, who died November 21, 1739. He married, second, Elizabeth Coggin, of Woburn, February, 4, 1740.

Esther Wyman, "was the daughter of Capt. Seth Wyman". She m. about 1742-3 John Hathorn. He was b. Dec. 28, 1720; d. 1777. He resided at Lynn and Wilmington, Mass. He is buried at Wilmington. (John Hathorn was son of Samuel (7), Ebenezer (6), John of Salem (5), William of Binfield, Eng. (4), William (3), Thomas (2), and Thomas (1) of Fray, Eng. b. about 1490- see "Hathorn Families of Maine" by Rev. Chas. N. Sinnett.)

John and Esther (Wyman) Hathorn had 9 children all born at Wilmington, Mass.

After his death, she took her children to Woolwich, Maine.

Eliner Wayman and George James, of Salem, Great Britain, were married in Boston, February 6, 1711.

Sarah Wayman and Edward Jones, of Great Britain, were published in Boston June 19, 1714.

Sarah Weyman and Samuel Marshall were married in Boston December 26, 1717.

John Weeman came from Germany and settled in Maine.

Nathaniel Wyman, No. 126.

Settled in Lancaster, Massachusetts, and bought his home farm of Matthew Stone, of Sudbury, November 29, 1742, said farm remaining in possession of his descendants to the present date, 1880, married Mary Sawyer, June 29, 1743, who died May 8, 1759, re-married to Submit Brooks, May 14, 1761, who died November 25, 1804. Nathaniel died June 5th, 1776.
