INTRODUCTION



HIS book is dedicated to the
 Whitmarsh cousins whose in terest in each other has led to
 the collection and publication
 of this genealogy.

The book is a revision and enlargement of a pamphlet of Whitmarsh Genealogy published by the author fourteen years ago. The record of the first five generations of the descendants of John Whitmarsh of Weymouth, Mass., is given here, so far as they could be obtained. Later generations are given only as material came to hand, and are chiefly of the immediate branch of the author's ancestry.

Little attempt has been made to record descendants outside of the Whitmarsh name, except that some of the descendants of Jacob Whitmarsh, No. 35, are given in other families, and all descendants of Jacob, No. 44.

The earlier generations of descendants of John Whitmarsh resided at Weymouth, gradually moving south to Abington and Bridgewater. Samuel, No. 9, removed to Dighton, Mass., where some of his descendants are still found. Jacob, No. 35, went to Cummington, Mass., and his descendants are numerous in that region. Later generations scattered to all points of the west. The double dating used in a few cases needs explanation only by recollecting that in 1751 the English parliament changed the calendar then in use, decreeing that the legal year should begin January 1, instead of April 25. As a result Old Style and New Style dating were both used from January 1 to April 25, to make sure that the date was correctly understood. Thus Peter Whitmarsh, No. 18, was born Jan. 10, 1713-14; that is, Jan. 10, 1713 by the Old Style calendar, but Jan. 10, 1714 by the New Style.

It may be of interest to note that by marriage with families from Plymouth some of the descendants have ancestors who came over in the Mayflower.

Jacob Whitmarsh, No. 44, married Olive Packard, daughter of Adam Packard and Abigail Porter, who was daughter of Jacob Porter and Rachel Reed. Rachel Reed was daughter of Daniel Reed, son of William Reed, son of William Reed and Esther Thompson, daughter of John Thompson and Mary Cook, the daughter of Francis Cook of the Mayflower.

The Reed ancestry goes back, it is claimed, to Withred, King of Kent in the seventh century, and, inferentially, to Cerdic the Saxon, who landed in Britain, A. D. 486. Nicholas Whitmarsh, No. 10, probably married Mercy Thompson, daughter of John Thompson and Mary Cook, daughter Francis Cook of the Mayflower.

Jacob Whitmarsh, No. 35, married Anna Pool, daughter of Samuel Pool and Ruth Fullerton, daughter of John Fullerton and Ruth Sampson. Ruth Sampson was, probably, daughter of Caleb Sampson and Mercy Standish, daughter of Alexander Standish, son of Miles Standish, and Sarah Alden, daughter of John and Priscilla Alden of the Mayflower. The connecting link, which is the parentage of Ruth Sampson, is questioned, but the weight of evidence is in favor of the ancestry as given above.

Thanks are due to many friends and relatives for assistance in securing the data for this work.

In the earlier generations thanks are especially due to the late Frank A. Bates of South Braintree, Mass., for his assistance, which his acquaintance with Braintree and Weymouth genealogy made of the greatest value.

The record of the descendants of Samuel, No. 9, who went to Dighton, Mass., was procured by George B. Stackpole, of Taunton, Mass., in 1906, with additions by a few later descendants. For the genealogy of the descendants of William, No. 25, acknowledgment is made of the service rendered by Charles W. Whitmarsh, formerly of Cleveland, Ohio, now of Los Angeles, Cal., and his brother, Henry W. Whitmarsh, of Los Angeles.

Nash's History of Weymouth, Mitchell's History of Bridgewater, and the church and town records of Weymouth and Abington have proved of great assistance.

Especial mention should be made of the financial assistance given by Thomas C. Whitmarsh, of St. Louis, who has borne a large share of the expense of publication.

While no promises are made as to a future publication, the author wishes to continue the collection of material and will be pleased to receive corrections and additions to the data concerning omitted members of the family, which will be printed in case a supplement should be issued. It will, therefore, be a favor if every one who comes into possession of a copy of this work will send his name and address to the author, with such additional data as may be available.

Whitmarsh Genealogy

WHITMARSH GENEALOGY

1. JOHN WHITMARSH, the immigrant ancestor of the Whitmarsh family in America, was one of Rev. Joseph Hull's company that sailed from Weymouth, England, March 20, 1635. The family is given in the passenger list as follows:

"Jno. Whitmarsk aged 39 yeare, Alce Whitmarke his Wife aged 35 yeare, Jms Whitmarcke his sonne aged 11 yeare, Jane his daughter aged 7 yeare, Onseph Whitmarke his sonne aged 5 yeare, Rich: Whytemark his sonne aged 2 yeare."

It will be observed that the name is spelled in for \cdot different ways, but always with k instead of h. The different spelling is due probably to the ignorance or carelessness of the clerk, but the presence of the k suggests a possible origin for the name. If Whytemark is the original form, the name perhaps was descriptive of some early ancestor.

Another suggested derivation of the name is from Whitnash.

The simplest derivation, if the name were Whitmarsh at the beginning, is that some ancestor dwelt near a marsh, known as the white marsh, and came to be known as "John of the white marsh" or John Whitmarsh. These derivations are, however, only conjecture. The English home of John Whitmarsh, the immigrant, is not yet positively determined, but there is reason to think that he may have come from Batcombe, Somerset County, England, as the "Genealogy of Richard Porter of Weymouth" mentions among those who came to Weymouth, John Whitmarsh and William Reed of Batc.mbe. There are Whitmarsh families in the south of England at present.

On July 8, 1635, the General Court of Massachusetts passed an order permitting Rev. Joseph Hull's company of twenty-one families to settle at Wessaguscus, which was incorporated under the name of Weymouth, Sept. 2, 1635.

Town records show that John Whitmarsh owned several pieces of land in Weymouth, before 1644, including "two acres upon the plain," "three acres upon King Oak Hill," "two acres in west field," "two and one-half acres of fresh marsh," "five acres on King Oak Hill," besides other lands.

There is also a description of lands of Nicholas, Richard, Onesiphorus and Simon Whitmarsh, mentioning "nine acres in the westerneck first given to their father, John Whitmarsh, deceased." This proves that John Whitmarsh, immigrant, died before 1644. It also proves the existence of two sons. Nicholas and Simon, not mentioned in the passenger list.

In the description of John Harding's land. mention is made of "Halfe an acre of fresh marsh which he gave to John Whitmarsh sonn of the aforesaid John Whitmarsh." This establishes the fact that John Whitmarsh, immigrant, had a son John.

There is no record of the death of John Whitmarsh or of his wife, Alice, except the fact that he died before 1644.

We have no data to show the age of the three sons Simon. John and Nicholas, except the fact that Simon was a land owner before 1644. Possibly these three were elder sons who came over after the family was established here. If so, the order of ages may have been as follows:

SIMON² WHITMARSH (John¹), first 2. appears in the town records of Weymouth in 1644 as owning "two and one-half acres of land first given to John Whitmarsh. He married (1), Sarah, daughter of Capt. John Holbrook, and (2), Elizabeth, daughter of John Bicknell. His will, dated April 29, 1708, probated Sept. 9, 1708, leaves property valued at £151-18s-3d to wife Elizabeth, daughter Mary Jackson, son-in-law Edward Darby, daughter Alice, and son John. The widow and Samuel Vinson, brother-in-law, are executors

JOHN³ WHITMARSH (John²), 6. called also Increase, born Aug. 23, 1655, at Weymouth, married perhaps, Mary Harding, daughter of John Harding, son of Richard Harding. Proof of this is found in the fact that Oct. 31, 1682, John Whitmarsh was appointed administrator of the estate of John Harding "in right of Mary, the only child." Richard Harding was probably the brother of John whose daughter Sarah married John² Whitmarsh (John¹). John Whitmarsh, Jr., mariner, buys 5 acres of land next the town burying place and a mansion house that was the dwelling of Rev. Mr. Torry, Feb. 12, 1723-4. of Sarah Torry, widow of Micajah Torry. Perhaps lost at sea.

7. EBENEZER^a WHITMARSH (John^a³), was born at Weymouth May 14, 1658, died at Abington April 8, 1718. He married Christian Bayley, 1682, daughter of Thomas and Ruth (Porter) Bayley. She was born Feb. 26, 1661, at Weymouth and died Jan. 7, 1731-32, at Abington.

They removed probably to Bridgewater and then to Abington. Five children were born at Weymouth, the last recorded being Nov. 1, 1703. A deed is on record signed by Ebenezer and his wife Christian, dated June

27, 1709, in which he is called "formerly of Weymouth, now of Bridgewater." He was one of the eight members to sign the original covenant of the First Church of Abington, and was chosen its first deacon. Dec. 18, 1714.

DIVISIONAL DEED OF LANDS OF EBENEZER WHITMARSH

The following is a copy of the divisional deed of the lands of Ebenezer³ (John²) Whitmarsh, in possession of the author:

Whereas our honored Father Ebenezer Whitmarsh of Abington in the County of Plymouth in New England, of late deceased, has in his last will and testament given unto us, Richard Whitmarsh, Ebenezer Whitmarsh, and Thomas Whitmarsh, a certain grant of land, it being upland and meadow which he bought of Captn. Byram, lying in the township of Bridgewater, to be equally divided between us for quantity and quality, therefore this Indenture made on the 6th day of March Anno Domini 1727-8 and in the first year of the Reigne of our Soveraigne Lord George the Second King of England &c., between the above said Richard Whitmarsh, Ebenezer Whitmarsh and Thomas Whitmarsh, all of Abington aforesaid, between them and their heirs and assigns forever, Wit-nesseth yt ye said Richard Whitmarsh is to take his part of said tract of land and meadow as follows (viz), Beginning att ye south-east corner of said Tract att a horn-pine marked on four sides which is the south-easterly corner of said tract of upland, and running from said horn-pine west on ye south line of said tract to a white oak marked on four sides, which is ye south-west corner of said meadow, and from said white oak northerly by Johnson's meadow thirty and four rods to a stake, and from said stake running east to the easterly line of the meadow lott, bearing the wedth of thirty and four rods to said line, and then running northerly on ye east line of ye meadow lott to a stake by a rock, and from said stake running east to the easterly line of the upland lott, and from thence running southerly to the bound first mentioned.

And the Thomas Whitmarsh aforesaid is to take his part of meadow and upland as follows, viz., beginning at the north-west of Richard Whitmarsh's meadow above said, and running from said northwest corner of said Richard's lott thirty and nine rods northerly on the west line of said meadow lott to a stake, and running from said stake east to a white birch marked, which stands in the meadow lott east line, and running from said birch southerly to the north-east corner of Richard Whitmarsh's meadow above specifyed. And as to the upland that raid Thomas Whitmarsh is to have for his part in this present division, it is as follows (viz). Beginning at the north-west corner of said Richard Whitmarsh's upland before specifyed, and said corner bound running east by Richard's part above said to the east line of ye Tract and running northerly on said east line to a stump marked, and from thence running west to the east line of the meadow lott, which part of ve upland is to contain about thirty acres.

And Ebenezer Whitmarsh above said is to take his part of ye meadow as follows (viz), Beginning at ye north-west corner of said Thomas Whitmarsh's part of ye meadow and running northerly on ye west line of meadow lott northerly on ye west line of meadow lott to a stake and an heap of stones which is the north-west corner of said Tract of meadow in present division, and running from thence easterly on ye north line of ye lott to a heap of stones which is ye north-east corner of ye meadow lott in present division, and from said heap of stones to a stake and heap of stones which is twenty 26 rods northerly from ye heap of stones att ve corner last mentioned, and from said stake and heap of stones running easterly ten rods to another stake and heap of stones, and from thence southerly 26 rods to a white oak marked, and from said white oak running by a strait line to ye northeasterly corner of Thomas Whitmarsh's meadow lott before specified. And the said Ebenezer Whitmarsh is to take for his part of ve upland in this division all ye northerly end of said upland lott so far as Thomas Whitmarsh's part before mentioned.
