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### INTRODUCTION.

#### TO MY COUSIN AND FRIENDS:

In offering this little history of the Wood family and genealogical record of the descendants of Joseph Wood, it is with a certain knowledge of the fact that time is passing rapidly and that memory is very uncertain; that dates that have not been recorded are soon forgotten; that many circumstances and incidents connected with our ancestors and known to our parents are gone with them; and that what we of the present remember will, to some extent, be forgotten, prompts me to prepare and publish this book.

I have held closely to facts, and have made no special sketches of individuals or families, no comparisons of wealth or social standing. I am satisfied that the names of all the descendants of Joseph and Katherine Day Wood, with dates of births, deaths and marriages, are recorded in this volume, a circumstance which is very seldom accomplished in works of this kind.

I wish to offer my thanks to those who have so kindly assisted me in furnishing dates and records.

### HISTORY

OF THE

### WOOD FAMILY.

JOSEPH WOOD, our common ancestor, who settled on a farm along the Octoraro creek, in West Nottingham township, Chester Co., Pa., somewhere about 1758, was the son of Thomas and Mary Wood, who emigrated from Warwickshire, England, between 1725 and 1730.

Thomas Wood settled near London Grove, Chester Co., Pa. He bought lands from William Penn in West Marlborough township, on the north side of the Street road, about one mile west of London Grove Meeting House, where he built a fulling mill.

Thomas Wood was a Churchman. His father was Ottowell Wood, who lived in Lancastershire, England. Thomas had one brother, John Wood, who remained in England and who was for several terms a member of the English Parliament.

William Wood, oldest son of Thomas and Mary Wood, was born 6th mo., 22d, 1723, in Warwickshire, England,

and died 4th mo., 20th, 1775. He married, on 10th mo., 6th, 1749, Margaret Holland, daughter of Thomas and Margaret Holland, of Prince George county, Maryland, in London Grove Meeting House. This William Wood was the ancestor of the Woods living at and near Doe Run, Chester Co., Pa.

In the passage over from England a daughter was born to Thomas and Mary Wood, who was named Richmonday, the name being taken from Rich, the name of the captain of the vessel, and Monday, the day of her birth. She afterwards married William Sheppard, of Menallen, now in Adams county, Pa.

Joseph Wood was the second son of Thomas and Mary Wood, and was born about 1730, no doubt at London Grove, Chester Co., Pa., where his father then lived. He is first mentioned in meeting records in the minutes of Warrington Monthly Meeting, of York county, where, on a recommendation of Menallen Preparative Meeting, dated 10th mo., 19th, 1754, Joseph Wood was admitted to membership with Friends as a member of Warrington Monthly and Menallen Particular Meeting.

Joseph Wood was married about this time, for there is a record of Warrington Monthly Meeting, dated 8th mo., 19th, 1758, in which he produced an acknowledgment to that meeting for having been married by a priest, which was accepted and ordered to be read at Menallen Meeting. There is no positive information who this first wife was, and very little account of his children by this wife.

There are these records in existence:

Old Swedes Church of Philadelphia, Aug. 27, 1755: Joseph Wood married Jane Dixson. From the records of the Pennsylvania marriage licenses, dated October, 1747, Joseph Wood and Mary Shull were licensed to marry.

From the First Presbyterian Church of Philadelphia records, dated 4th mo., 2d, 1748, Joseph Wood and Eleanor Hale were married.

At that time Friends and Friendly people were more generally associated with the Episcopal Church than any other, so it is probable that the first record is the one we are interested in, that from Old Swedes Church.

The first knowledge we have of Joseph Wood after he settled on the Octoraro creek, in Chester Co., Pa., is a minute of East Nottingham Monthly Meeting, dated the 15th day of 12th mo., 1759, held at East Nottingham. A certificate was received from Warrington Monthly Meeting recommending Joseph Wood to the care and notice of that meeting, and he seems to have been an active member of East Nottingham Meeting for some years. A record, dated 25th of 1st mo., 1765, speaks of him being accepted as an overseer of East Nottingham Monthly Meeting.

Of his children by his first wife, the only record we have is at a monthly meeting held at East Nottingham the 27th of 8th mo., 1768: West Nottingham Preparative Meeting mentions that Joseph Wood requests that his three children, John, Mary and Rebecca, might be looked upon as members of the Society.

John probably died in early life, as we have no further account of him. Mary married — Wiley, and was the grandmother of William Hiram Wiley, who was raised at his Uncle David Wood's. Rebecca married — McMullen.

William Hiram Wiley was born 11th mo., 21st, 1829. His address is Fairmount, West Virginia. He had three brothers and one sister:

Thomas Allen Wiley, born 5th mo., 26th, 1820; died 3d mo., 4th, 1898.

John Wiley, born 5th mo., 26th, 1822; died in Baltimore, Md., in 1875.

Joseph Wiley was born 10th mo., 31st, 1824, and died at Philadelphia in 1863.

Mary Elizabeth Wiley was born 6th mo., 9th, 1827. She married, lived and died in Massachusetts, leaving a family of four children.

Hiram Wiley, the father of the children just mentioned, was the son of Mary Wiley, the oldest daughter of Joseph Wood. He married Elizabeth Kurst, of York, Pa., and died 12th mo., 24th, 1834, she dying 12th mo., 8th, 1837.

Joseph Wood was married on the 12th day of 1st mo., 1869, to Katherine Day, daughter of John and Lydia Day, of East Nottingham, Chester Co., Pa.

John Day, father of Katherine Day, died early in the year 1775. Lydia, his wife, died 1st mo., 3d, 1799.

Katherine Day Wood was born 6th mo., 25th, 1743, died 6th mo., 26th, 1822, and was buried in the burying-ground at Eastland, Pa.

The following is a copy of the marriage certificate as recorded in the minutes of East Nottingham Monthly Meeting:

WHEREAS: Joseph Wood, of the Township of West Nottingham, in the County of Chester, and Province of Penusylvania, son of Thomas Wood, Deceased, and Mary his wife, and Katherine Day, Daughter of John and Lydia Day, his wife, of the Township of East Nottingham, in the County and Province aforesaid, having declared their intentions of taking each other in Marriage, before several Monthly Meetings of the people called Quakers, in East Nottingham, afforesaid, according to the good order used amongst them, and having consent of parents, there said proposal of Marriage, after deliberate Consideration (they appearing clear of all others), were allowed of by said Meeting.

Now These are to certify all whom it may concern, that for the full accomplishing their said Intentions this 12th Day of the first month, in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Nine, they, the said Joseph Wood and Katherine Day, appeared in a publick Meeting of the said people assembled at the Publick Meeting House in East Nottingham, afforesaid, where he, the said Joseph Wood, taking her, the said Katherine Day, by the hand, did, in a solemn manner, openly Declare that he took her to be his wife, Promising, thro' Divine Assistance, to be unto her a loving and faithful Husband untill death should Separate them; And then and there, in the said assembly, she, the said Katherine Day, did in like manner openly declare that she took the said Joseph Wood to be her Husband, promising, thro' Divine Assistance, to be unto him a loving and faithful wife untill Death should separate them, or words to the same effect.

Moreover, they, the said Joseph Wood and Katherine Day, she (according to the Custom of Marriage assuming the name of Her Husband), as a further Confirmation thereof, did then and there to these presents set their hands.

Samuel England and John White were appointed to attend the marriage and report how it was conducted, and to have the certificate recorded.

The following minutes are worthy of notice:

At a monthly Meeting held at East Nottingham 27th of 2d mo., 1779, West Nottingham Preparative Meeting mentions that Joseph Wood has answered a sum of money that his brother in law has paid for him in lieu of Personal Service in war. William Haines and Benjamin Wilson are appointed to treat with him, on this meetings behalf, in order to convince his judgment of his error in so doing.

At a Monthly Meeting held at East Nottingham 3d of 4th mo., 1779,—

The Friends appointed to treat with Joseph Wood report that they had an opportunity with him, and that he

did not appear to be convinced of an Error in what he had done; never the less Joshua Brown and William Webster are desired to pay him another visit, that if possible he may be helped to see his present state.

At a Monthly Meeting held at Nottingham the 24th day of 4th mo., 1779:—

The Friends in the case of Joseph Wood reported they had another opportunity with him, and he appeared to them to be in some degree Convinced of his Error, and, Being present, several suitable hints were proved to him; the Meeting appears most easy to wait longer with him, in hopes he be more fully convinced of the matter he has failed in and Leaves his case in the care of the former Comittee; and Joseph Harlan added, Who are to Labor further for his help.

At Nottingham Monthly Meeting, held at Little Britain the 28th day of 8th mo., 1779:

Richard Reynolds reports the Acknowledgment Given by Joseph Wood, it was read and is as follows:—

Whereas I, the subscriber, for want of due Consideration some time ago, Submitted to satisfy a man with a sum of money that he had some time before paid, without my knowledge, to the Constable for my son's Substitute fine, so called, which I of late see to be inconsistant with the principles held by Friends. I do desire that I may give more close attention to the pure principle and that my conduct hereafter may be consistant there with. Given forth from under my hand the 31st day of the 7th month, 1779.

JOSEPH WOOD.

Joseph Wood died 12th mo., 10th, 1797, aged 67 years, and was buried at Friends' Burying Ground at West Nottingham, Cecil Co., Md.

The old place where Joseph Wood settled is on the

south side of the Octoraro creek. The stone house is still standing, but has not been in use as a dwelling since the memorable June flood of 1884. At this time the water was high enough to enter the second story, the people living there having to be rescued from the roof. This flood partially tore away the walls of the house, and as it has never been restored, it stands just as it did in 1884.

This property was taken up and surveyed to John Williamson, a fuller, on the 10th day of 6th mo., 1746, and contained 124 acres and allowances. It was next sold to John Cook, a blacksmith, the deed bearing the date of August 21st, 1754; consideration, 240 pounds. John Cook sold it to Joseph Wood, of York Co., Pa., on the 10th day of October, 1758, who, on the payment of 19 pounds 4 shillings and 4 pence additional, obtained a patent deed, dated 12th of January, 1760.

Thomas and Jesse Wood, executors of Joseph Wood, deceased, sold Samuel Carter, miller, this same property deed, bearing date of May 25th, 1801; consideration, 1,000 pounds.

Samuel Carter sold to Jesse Wood, millwright, deed dated June 8th, 1801; consideration, 1,000 pounds.

Jesse Wood sold to David Wood, deed dated April 1st, 1814; price, \$7,350.

David Wood bought from Charles Riley an additional tract of 21 acres, joining the main property on the south; deed dated March 17th, 1831; price, \$187.50.

David Wood sold the two tracts to his son, Abner C. Wood; deed dated July 19th, 1844; price, \$8,000. A survey at this time found the two places to contain 168 acres.

Abner C. Wood's executor sold to Samuel Conrad; deed dated April 1st, 1889; price, \$4,462. Surveyed Nov. 21st and 22d, 1889, and found to contain 184 acres and 26 perches.

Sold by Samuel Conrad's assignee at public sale to Jesse Wood, on October 7th, 1901; price, \$2,500.

This property, with an exception of eleven years, has been in the possession of some of the descendants of Joseph Wood for 145 years.

# COPY OF THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JOSEPH WOOD.

Be it known to all whom it may concern that I, Joseph Wood, of the Township of West Nottingham, in the County of Chester, and State of Pennsylvania, being at this time of a sound mind and memory, and calling to mind the uncertainty of time here in this world and that it is once appointed for all men to die, do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament here by disanuling and making void all former will or wills made by me.

1st. My will is that my body be decently Buried in a Plain Christian manner, at the discretion of my executors hereafter named, and that my just Debts and funeral charges shall be all paid.

2nd. My will is that my Beloved Wife shall have the best bed and bedding that is in my possession at my deceas as that she shall chose.

3rd. My will is that my personal Estate be sold as soon as Conveniency will admit of after my deceas and my Real estate in one year after my deceas, and that my Widow remain in possession of it during that year, except that part of my Land that I bought of Sarah Priest, which lays in Little Britain township, in Lancaster County, and that Land that belongs to me that is in pardership with John

Reed, up in that calld the new Purchase up Susquahanna, that Joseph Green procor'd for us.

4th. My Will is that all my Estate, real and personal, that is to be sold, shall be divided between my wife and nine children, in manner following (i. e.): Mary Wiley, Rebeckah McMullen, Joseph, Jesse, Lydia, Elisabeth, David, John and Day Wood, the boys to have as much more as my Wife and the Girls is to have, and my Wife shall have Twenty five Pounds out of my son Josephs part.

5th. My Will is that my son Thomas Wood shall have all my land in Lancaster County, Little Britain Township, that I bought of Sarah Priest, to him and his Heirs and Assigns forever, that remains unsold to John Jones, adjoining the Lands of Reger Sage, Samuel Carter and John Jones, supposed to be one hundred acres, be it more or less and no more.

6th. I give to my daughter Rebeckah McMullen all my right, title and Interest to and in that tract of land in Pardnership with John Reed up Susquahanna, in Northumberland County, in the afforesaid state, to her and to her Heirs and Assigns forever, and it is to be to her for Thirty Seven Pounds ten shillings of that part of my estate that she was to have that is to be sold and divided between my Wife and Children.

7th. And lastly I appoint my two sons, Thomas and Jesse Wood, my Whole and Soal Executors of this my Last Will and testament. Signed, sealed and Acknowledged in the Presence of us this first Day of the first month Anno Domine 1797.


