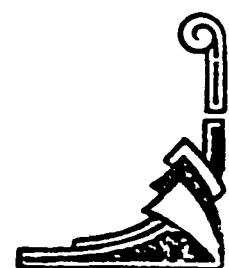

FOREWORD

The purpose of this booklet is to record the descendants of Thomas Newby White I, son of Thomas White and Jemima Johnson White. The index begins with the name of Thomas White.

The first few pages of the booklet give facts about the ancestry of Thomas White back to the time when that branch of the family left England and came to the New World. They also give a few historical notes about the ten children of Thomas White, of whom Thomas Newby White I was the youngest.

A section of the booklet is devoted to each of the eleven children of Thomas Newby White I and Lydia Parker White, except for the two who died in infancy and Maria, who died in youth, unmarried. Each section lists a child with the descendants of that child.



Record of White family obtained by Mildred E. White from Fernando C. White of Belvidere, N.C. (deceased). His distant ancestors and ours, were the same. Our line is marked with a star, in each case.

* John White came from Whitley, England to Isle of Wight County, Virginia. (died 1718). He married twice in Virginia. His first wife Rachel had only one son who is now known. He was Thomas White (b. 1696-d. 11th month 30, 1761). He married Rachel Jordan, dau. of Joshua and Elizabeth Sanborn Jordan (b. third month 24th, 1703-d. sixth month sixteen, 1768). Fernando C. White of Belvidere was one of his many descendants. Fernando C. White had a wonderful family tree of John White's descendants.

John White's second wife was Elizabeth. Their issue is as follows:

RECORD OF PINEY WOODS MEETING IN EASTERN QUARTER OF NORTH CAROLINA YEARLY MEETING

Piney Woods Friends Meeting was the meeting to which the Whites

of Belvidere, N.C. belonged. Thomas Newby White I, whose descendants are listed here was a birthright member.

Piney Woods Meeting was officially set up in 1794. As early as 1754 meetings were held in Piney Woods meetinghouse. Mentioned as members in old records are John White, Nathaniel Newby, Thomas Nicholson. In 1762 week-day meetings heretofore held at the home of Caleb Elliott were removed to Piney Woods meetinghouse.

A RECORD OF THE LIFE OF EXUM WHITE, SON OF * THOMAS WHITE

Exum White, son of Thomas and Jemima Johnson White married Ann Hare, who was from Somerton, Nansemond County, Va. They

lived for a time at Belvidere, Perquimans Co., N.C. (Piney Woods Meeting). Their first child, Sarah, was born there in 1826. Their third child, Joseph Hare, was born in 1830 at Somerton, Va., where Ann Hare White had been reared. They moved with their three children to Wayne Co., Indiana, but later moved to a farm near Spiceland in Henry County, Indiana. Jesse Thomas, their fourth child was born there in 1832, as was also their fifth in 1835 and their sixth, John Gurney in 1838. Their seventh and last child Elizabeth, was born in Wayne County at West Grove (north of Centerville) in 1840. Exum White died at West Grove 2-4-1843 and was buried there. There was a Friends meeting at West Grove.

At the time of Joseph Hare's birth in Somerton, Va., Thomas Newby White, Exum's youngest brother, was living with Exum's family, both his parents having died. He was twelve years old. When Exum moved with his family to Indiana in 1832, Thomas Newby was with them. Exum eventually bought the Charles Bundy farm in Indiana, Henry Co. In 1838 they settled two miles north of Centerville at West Grove. Ann White was a true mother to Thomas Newby. Exum died in 1843. The family returned to Henry County where Joseph worked for wages until 1850 when he bought his farm north of the Richsquare meetinghouse. After Joseph's marriage, his mother lived with him.

Thomas Newby stayed with Exum White until about 1840, then worked for wages until 1843 when he bought his farm south of the Richsquare meetinghouse. He married Lydia Parker April 25, 1844, and began his home in a log cabin. As Ann White had been left a widow in 1843, with some children still at home to be cared for, Thomas Newby White built a cabin on his farm at Richsquare for her. She was a good practical nurse and used her skill for the neighborhood. When her son Joseph married and had a home of his own, Ann went to live with him, and was lovingly cared for the rest of her life. She died at Richsquare.

Several of Ann White's family died without progeny. Some died of tuberculosis, to which many of the pioneers fell victim.

THE STORY OF THE BACKGROUND OF THOMAS NEWBY WHITE I AND THE EXODUS OF HIS FAMILY FROM BELVIDERE, N.C. TO INDIANA.

The home of Thomas and Jemima White was at Belvidere, N.C. about eight miles northwest of Hertford. The hamlet of Belvidere is on the Perquimans river. Thomas, born in 1777, during the Revolution, at Belvidere, a birthright member of the Piney Woods meeting, married Jemima Johnson, from Somerton Friends meeting in Virginia. They had ten children, of whom Exum White was the eldest and Thomas Newby the youngest.

Both parents died while most of their children were still quite young. By about 1830 both were gone. Exum White, the eldest son, assumed responsibility for his father's family. In 1832 this family of Whites left Belvidere and migrated by covered wagon to Indiana, stopping for some two years in Wayne County, at West Grove meeting, two miles north of Centerville, then moving west to Spiceland in Henry County. After the death of Exum White, the family settled in Richsquare, eight miles south of New Castle, east of the New Castle pike.

Let us see the family as they set forth to Indiana, leaving their old ties forever, leaving their beloved parents at rest in the family burial ground of the Whites and the Nicholsons, situated by the Perquimans river, between the White and the Nicholson farms at Belvidere. In those days the only headstones used by Friends were of rough field stone, with no names carved on them. A marker more pretentious than this was regarded as a sign of "creaturely activity" and frowned upon. The marker on the grave of Thomas White is of undressed stone.

Three of the ten children had died in North Carolina. Pheriba had died in 1816 at the age of fifteen years. Two had died in 1827, Margaret at nineteen, and David at thirteen. As fevers were very prevalent in that climate, it may be wondered if these two died of typhoid or malaria, and it is possible that the parents died of one of these same diseases.

Exum White was married before the exodus, and his son Joseph Hare was born in 1830 in Somerton, Nansemond County, Virginia,

from which place his wife, Ann Hare, had come. One supposes that Exum White had taken a farm there fairly soon after his marriage.

Sarah was also married before the exodus, to Frederick Newby. The family tradition is that this young couple did not migrate to Indiana when Exum and the rest left. They did follow later, however, and settled on a farm in the vicinity of Spiceland, Henry County.

Maria was 27 or 28 years old. As she later married Daniel Johnson, it seems likely that the marriage took place in Indiana.

Betsy Ann was 24 or 25, unmarried. She married John Macy in Indiana, after the death of his first wife.

Josiah was nineteen or twenty when they came up to Indiana. He died at the age of twenty-five. We have no record of any children. Perhaps he had not married.

Lydia was but fifteen or sixteen years old. She married Robert Hall in Indiana.

Thomas Newby was thirteen or fourteen and looked to his brother Exum as to a father, and to his wife Ann as a mother. Exum died in 1843. We know that Thomas Newby graduated from Spiceland Academy and taught in the Richsquare Friends School. The year after his brother's death, that is, in 1844, he married Lydia Parker, dau. of Robert and Miriam Bell Parker. He lived all his married life at Richsquare and died there in 1899.

BACKGROUND OF LYDIA PARKER WHITE, WIFE OF THOMAS N. WHITE I

Lydia Parker was born February 15, 1827. She died at Richsquare, Indiana, November 15, 1898. Her father was Robert Parker, who died in 1838. Her mother was Miriam Bell Parker, b. 1795; d. 1840. Miriam Bell Parker was a daughter of John Bell. Lydia was but eleven years old when her father died, and only thirteen when her mother died. At seventeen she married Thomas N. White I, who was then twenty-five years old. She had eleven chil-

dren, of whom two died in infancy. She died at the age of seventy-one and lies at rest at Richsquare.

Lydia Parker White lived all her married life at the Old White Homestead at Richsquare — for four years in a cabin and then in a white brick home for which the bricks were burned on the farm. Let us look back to see the generation back of her father, Robert. Robert's father was Jeremiah Parker, who was a charter member of the Richsquare Meeting in Henry County, Indiana, and was the first head of that meeting when it was set up in 1834. He also gave it its name, as he was the oldest member. He named it after the old Richsquare in Eastern Quarter of North Carolina Yearly Meeting, from which he migrated with his family some few years before the meeting was set up. Jeremiah Parker's wife was Keren Parker. Thomas N. White I was kind to the widow Ann White and her children. After he was married and settled, he built a cabin on his farm for them. Ann worked as a practical nurse in homes in times of illness. None of her daughters survived to leave descendants. Ann spent her last years in the home of her son Joseph H. and died at the age of eighty-three, much beloved by her grandchildren. The tradition is that at least some of the daughters died of tuberculosis, which took the lives of so many of the pioneers.

Thomas N. and Lydia White lived in a log cabin on their farm until 1848, when Thomas N. burned bricks on his own place and built a sturdy story-and-a-half house. The very night after they moved from the cabin into the new house, Mary Abigail White was born. They had had two children in the log house. Anzonetta, the first child, died in infancy, from what cause is not known. Maria was their second child, and she lived until she was eighteen years old. She died of typhoid at Friends Boarding School at Richmond, which later became Earlham College. Travel was so difficult in those days, and communication by letter so slow and so rare, that the parents did not know of her illness until they were informed of her death. Maria lies buried in the cemetery at Richsquare. The grief over her death was a shadow on them all their lives, yet they had the courage to send their other children in turn to Earlham, all but Edward Newby, the youngest, who was uninterested and declined to go.

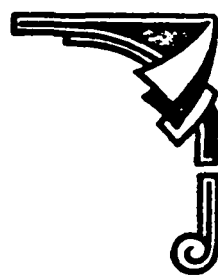
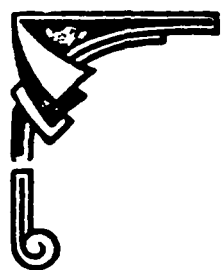

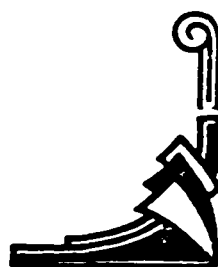

Note: The above-mentioned John Rigg (b. 1852; d. 1931) was the
son of Andrew T. Rigg and Jane Walker Rigg. This family mi-
grated from England to New Zealand in 1890. Theodore, their de-
scendant who married Esther Mary White, was born in 1888. He
became acquainted with Esther Mary White in Russia, where both
were doing relief work under Friends Service organizations. They
were married in Philadelphia where the White family then lived.
The wedding was after the manner of Friends, and took place in
