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Introduction

As you know, since 1790, the Federal Government has conducted a census of the population every ten years. From 1790 to 1840 the census taker listed the head of the household by name, and the age and sex of all persons (related or not) living in the household. In 1850, this procedure was changed and each person in the household was also listed by name.

To use the enclosed census information you must know the name of an ancestor (named Whiteside) who was born prior to 1880. By checking the Index to the Censuses (page 14-18) one can readily discover if he is listed in the enclosed material. If he is listed all that remains is to check the page or pages listed next to his name. In most cases he was living in a household that I have genealogically connected to other families. (see pages iii-). As one might expect, however, most persons cannot be connected to the original founder of their family in the United States, some not even to their own immediate family. Only with diligent effort on the part of all of us will the connecting links be established.

As usual, the enclosed information is free of charge. My only request is that you carefully check the information on your family, noting errors in spelling of names, filling in full middle names, maiden names, date of death, place of burial, and connecting links. If you will then send these corrections to me the entire kindred will benefit from the information. Also, if you know of anyone who can provide information on any of the branches of the family please let me know.

It is truly hoped that this information will stimulate your interest in research on the genealogy of the family. This material is only a stepping stone, not the final product.

There were only 75 copies of this information distributed. Therefore, when you are through with the material and if you no longer want to use it, please deposit your copy with your local library or Historical Society so that others, in years to come, may also use it.

Although we have tried to insure completeness, it is possible that omissions have occurred.

Further, we have followed the spelling of names as found in the census even though it is known to be in error.

Unless otherwise indicated the place of birth is Indian a.

Appreciation is extended to Mrs. Peter V. Heppen who greatly aided in the search of these censuses and to the Canada Council which provided a grant for this project.

It will be noted that on pages 3 and 6 are two families who list their place of birth as Germany. These are the only families in my file from countries other than England or Ireland. Comments would be appreciated.

Genealogical Connections of Heads of Household and Selected Others, Indiana.

The following statement introduced this section in previous attempts to accomplish the same task for Whitesides listed in other censuses. It is also applicable here.

"The attempt to trace ones genealogical history is fraught with problems. It is indeed difficult to find adequate information to 'prove' that person "A" who was born in 1790, is the son or daughter of person "B". If the parental line, which is most basic to our heritage, is difficult to reconstruct we can expect the worst when we attempt to reconstruct the sibling and cousin connections. In some instances, obviously, there is sufficient information about the persons to make a fairly certain judgement; but where the information is scant the problems abound. Hence, it is with a great deal of hesitation that I make these connections -- the information is meager. Yet, I feel this attempt should be made now, and revised as new information is uncovered.

"In cases where I do not have substantial evidence of the specific connection I use a question (?) prior to the name."

I have ordered the connections primarily by county.
