Introduction

The names in this report represent only those soldiers whose records are on file at the Archives in Washington, D.C.. We know these records are incomplete. For example, in my search of records in North Carolina and Tennessee I found 3 names (War of 1812) not listed in this report.

Thus, the names in this report must be supplemented with names located in the appropriate State Archives.

Upon completion of the form the Archives will send copies of the service record, pension claims and any bounty-land warrant application.

I have listed each person below the State which his unit is attached even though it is known the person so listed is personally from another State.

Also, I have omitted all the original file listings. That is, where a person is listed in the Index originally by one name and later by another. Each omission, however, is noted under the corrected name.

A word of caution: one person may have served in several organizations. I do not know how often such duplication of names occurs. As the Archives notes:

"...the record of a man's military service in any one organization is wholly separate from the record of his service in any other organization. We are ordinarily unable to establish the identity or nonidentity of men of the same name who served in different organizations."

Hopefully in a future report the names of Whitesides in the Mexican; Spanish American; and Civil War (Union) will be distributed.
