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FOREWORD

Some years ago, while doing research work upon other families, the compiler came across references which lead to some work upon the Witt family. The lack of data in printed sources, and rareness with which one finds mention of the name suggested further work at a future date.

When time permitted the former rough notes were expanded and further research performed in order that as complete records as possible be presented. The following pages present in print for the first time a record of this family.

There has been no attempt to reproduce all references, nor complete military records, nor probate or deed file numbers. To those who esire this information the "following up" of records here presented will reveal the sources of such data. There is also no attempt to fill space and complimentary material or biographical notes, this is a record of the family and its descendants as shown by a study of existing data and not a biographical history of the family.

It is possible that more complete records of this family could be compiled by a thorough study of the data of the DeWitt family. At several points descendants disappear and local historians report that the name of "DeWitt" was assumed by certain of the group. In several instances the compiler has proved these to be false statements, but only complete examination of all data involving both families could clear all conflicts and doubts.

The arrangement is that long standardized and used by the New England Historic Genealogical Society in its Register. Each succeeding generation is indicated by an exponent and numbers are assigned to those with descendants with possibility of issue bearing the family name. One exception occurs where no issue have yet been found, but future research may produce records of children at present unknown.

There has been no attempt to trace female lines beyond indicating the names of husbands. Neither has there been any attempt to carry records beyond the middle of the nineteenth century, as interested members of the family can easily connect family records with those erewith presented.

The compiler wishes to express herewith his gratitude to his wife, Edythe B. Balcomb, for her aid and encouragement in carrying on this study, and also for the preparation of the complete and exhaustive index.
