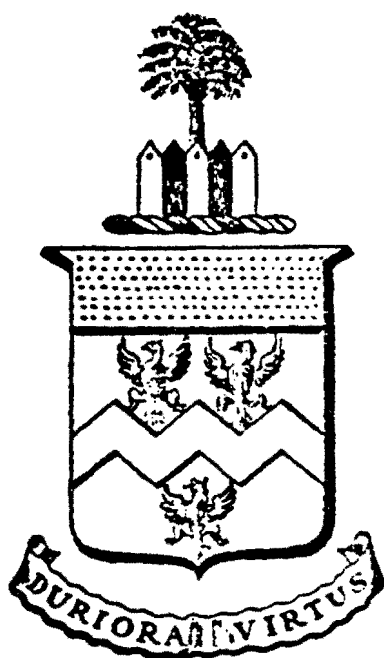

THE "WYATT" FAMILY
OF
BALTIMORE.

The Wyatt Family of Baltimore is distinct from, and in no way related to, any others of the name in America, being the descendants of the Rev. William Edward Wyatt, of Baltimore, who was the only son of James Wyatt of England, who was also, as far as is known, an only son.

The contents of this little book, of which only a limited number of copies has been printed, have been collected and arranged merely as an accurate genealogical statement for the benefit of the members of the family at present living, their descendants in the future, and any others to whom it may be of interest.

FIRST GENERATION

(In Baltimore)

James Wyatt, born at Bristol, England, 1748, and coming to America when a young man, married at Barbadoes, 1783, Mary Winslow, daughter of the Rev. Edward Winslow, of the Boston family and a brother of the then Governor of the Island. This Rev. Edward Winslow was an Episcopal clergyman of some distinction and now lies buried under the chancel of St. George's Church in the City of New York. He was a direct descendant in the fifth generation of John Winslow, who was a brother of Edward, the first Governor of the Massachusetts Colony. John married in 1623 Mary Chilton, a passenger on the "Maryflower" in 1620, and tradition says she was the first woman to step ashore at Plymouth, and therefore the first woman to set foot upon American soil. They settled in Boston soon after their marriage, and both lie buried in King's Chapel graveyard, where their tomb is conspicuously marked and engraved with the Winslow arms. All members of this Wyatt family are therefore direct "Mayflower Descendants," and as such eligible as members of that society.

The Rev. William Edward Wyatt, the only son of James Wyatt and his wife Mary Winslow, was born in Halifax, 1789, and immediately after his birth his parents moved to New York, which became their home, and where he was educated in school and college. He received the degree of A.B. from Columbia College in 1809, of M.A. in 1816, and of D.D. from the University of Maryland in 1818, and was made professor of theology in that University at the same time. He

was ordained priest in 1813 in Trinity Church, New York, by Bishop Hobart. In 1812 he married Frances Billop of Staten Island. In 1814 he was called to Baltimore, to be Associate Rector with Bishop James Kemp, of Old St. Paul's Church, on the corner of Charles and Saratoga Streets, and on the death of Bishop Kemp, in 1827 Dr. Wyatt became the sole Rector and moved into the old Rectory, built in 1792, on Saratoga Street, at the head of Liberty, probably at present the oldest brick house in Baltimore, and still known and occupied as the rectory residence of Old St. Paul's. Dr. Wyatt died there in 1865, after being the rector of St. Paul's for fifty-one years. and during that period was prominent as a "high-churchman" of that day, taking active part in the General Convention and Committee work of the church. His wife died a few months previous to his death, and both are buried in the Old St. Paul's cemetery, on West German Street. Dr. Wyatt's father and mother, James and Mary Winslow Wyatt accompanied him to Baltimore, living with him up to their death, and they also are buried in the old cemetery. All the children of Dr. Wyatt and his wife Frances Billop were born in Baltimore, and in the following pages is given the date of the birth, marriage, death, and the descendants of each, down to the present date, nineteen hundred and twenty.

As above shown the Winslow-Wyatt Family are of original Massachusetts and New York stock, settling in Baltimore in 1814.
