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EXPLANATION

In 1904 The State Historical Society of Iowa published a list of twenty-five topics in Iowa history under the title of *An Iowa Program for Study Clubs*. Three years later a revised and enlarged edition of this *Iowa Program* was brought out as *Bulletin of Information*, No. 6. This bulletin contained a list of thirty-two topics.

Interest in Iowa history increased rapidly, and in 1914 The State Historical Society published a bulletin entitled *One Hundred Topics in Iowa History*, compiled by Dan Elbert Clark. A second and revised edition of this bulletin was published in 1915. Since 1915 the amount of scientific and popular literature concerning Iowa history has multiplied many fold, and interest in the history of the State has increased from year to year.

Two Hundred Topics in Iowa History has been compiled by Dr. William J. Petersen, Research Associate in The State Historical Society of Iowa. Its purpose, like that of the earlier bulletins, is to give persons interested in Iowa a more or less classified list of references relating to the history of our Commonwealth. *Two Hundred Topics in Iowa History* will be especially useful to teachers of Iowa history, to those who wish to make a systematic study of Iowa history at home or by correspondence, and to clubs desiring to arrange Iowa history programs.

In compiling the reference lists which appear in this bulletin an effort has been made to give citations which are available and accessible to general readers of Iowa history rather than to present an exhaustive bibliography for research scholars.

The topics are arranged (in general) according to chronological sequence and subject matter. The references under each topic are listed alphabetically rather than in any order of estimated importance. To find a specific topic or reference, consult the index at the end of the bulletin.

A large number of the references are to historical magazines and periodicals — four of which have been published by The State Historical Society of Iowa, namely: the *Annals of Iowa*; the *Iowa Historical Record*; the *Iowa Journal of History and Politics*; and the *Palimpsest*. The *Annals of Iowa*, first series, cited here as *Annals* (1), includes

twelve volumes and covers the years from 1863 to 1874. This series is now out of print, and only a few libraries in the State have complete sets. A second series of the *Annals of Iowa*, cited here as Annals (2), containing three volumes, was published from 1882 to 1884. In 1885 The State Historical Society of Iowa began the publication of the *Iowa Historical Record*, cited here as Historical Record. It was continued until 1902 and contains eighteen volumes. The *Annals of Iowa*, third series, cited in this bulletin as Annals (3), is published at Des Moines by the Historical Department.

At present The State Historical Society of Iowa publishes two historical magazines: the *Iowa Journal of History and Politics* (referred to in the citations as the Iowa Journal), a quarterly which was begun in 1903; and the *Palimpsest*, a monthly periodical which was first issued in 1920.

Books published by The State Historical Society are marked SHSI, followed by the date of publication. In the case of books not published by the Society, the name of the publisher and the date of publication are given, unless the volume is known to be out of print. Only a few references to rare and out-of-print books have been included.

Public, school, and college libraries in Iowa are advised to secure as many as possible of the publications herein listed. Such a collection will meet all the ordinary demands for material on Iowa history.
