MICHIGAN PIONEER AND HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

HISTORY.

This society was organized April 22, 1874, in Representative Hall in the old State house at Lansing, under the name of the Pioneer Society of the State of Michigan, with the following named original members; Albert Miller, Bay City; Witter J. Baxter, Jonesville; Oliver C. Comstock, Marshall; D. Johnson Jackson; H. H. Bingham, Jackson; Randolph Strickland, St. Johns; John N. Ingersoll, Corunna; Ephraim Longyear, Lansing; W. W. Mitchell, Ionia; Erastus S. Ingersoll, Delta; Ebenezer Lakin Brown, Schoolcraft; David Scott, Dewitt; Henry P. Cherry, Johnstown; Smith Tooker, Lansing; Levi Bishop, Detroit; Chas. Dickey, Marshall; Horace Angell, Lansing; Warren Hopkins, Lansing; Martin B. Wood, Albion; Harriet A. Tenney, Lansing; John C. Holmes, Detroit; Alvin N. Hart, Lansing.

The name was changed June 13, 1888, to Michigan Pioneer and Historical Society (see Vol. 13, p. 24 Pioneer Collections), to make it conform more nearly

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to what the society really was, a historical as well as pioneer society.

The constitution as originally adopted provided for an annual subscription of not less than one dollar nor more than three dollars, which was amended June 11, 1890, by making the membership fee one dollar with no annual dues. (See Vol. 18, p. 9.)

The time for holding the annual meeting as originally adopted was the first Wednesday in February of each year. This was amended at the annual meeting of February 4, 1880, so that it might be held at such other time as the society might determine at any annual meeting (see Vol. 4, p. 5), and when this meeting adjourned it adjourned to meet again at the call of the executive committee (see Vol. 4, p. 8), and on February 1, 1881, the executive committee adopted the following:

Resolved, That hereafter the annual meetings of the State Pioneer Society be held at Lansing, on the first Wednesday in June, 1882, and on the first Wednesday in June, of each year thereafter.

Since that date the annual meetings have been held in June of each year.

The object of this society is to collect, procure and preserve anything and everything relating to the natural, civil, literary and ecclesiastical history of our State, and it solicits the cordial and active support of every pioneer and of every historical student of Michigan to aid in promoting the objects and interests of the society. It relies wholly upon voluntary contributions to its collections, and invites everyone to

donate any books, pamphlets or papers pertaining to the history of Michigan. Also biographies and incidents of pioneer life; maps, charts, manuscript narratives, diaries, correspondence, paintings, portraits, photographs, statuary, newspaper files, and Indian and other relics and curiosities of any kind. Much valuable matter has already been collected, and through the liberality of the State twenty volumes of "Pioneer and Historical Collections" have been published by the society.

Of these volumes there are twelve which contain histories of the settlement of townships and counties, with reminiscences of pioneer life, biographies of early settlers, and other interesting matter connected with the pioneer history of the State, and eight volumes which are made up of matter connected with the early French and English explorations in Michigan and the northwest, with official documents relating to the French, English and Indian wars and the war of the revolution, and also those relating to the war of 1812 so far as they transpired in the territory of Michigan, with a detailed account of the official correspondence which took place after the war of 1812, previous to and concerning the surrender of the territory by England. These official papers are all copied from the Canadian archives at Ottawa, Canada, by the agents of this society.

It is especially urged that all district, county, town, city or village pioneer or historical societies become auxiliary to this society under section seven of the act of incorporation, and thus through this society

preserve collections that otherwise might fall into careless hands and be lost.

A large membership from every portion of the State is very desirable and all persons who wish to become members are requested to send their names to the recording secretary, with the membership fee of one dollar, which constitutes them life members. Care should be taken to give the full name, date and place of birth, time and place of first residence in Michigan and present residence and postoffice address.

AN ACT

To provide for the Incorporation of State, county, or municipal historical, biographical, and geographical societies.

SECTION 1. *The People of the State of Michigan enact*, That any five or more persons and their successors that may hereafter associate together for the purpose of collecting and preserving historical biographical, or other information, in relation to the State of Michigan, or any portion thereof, may become a body corporate by complying with the requirements of this act.

SEC. 2. The persons intending to become a body corporate for the above named purpose, shall publish a notice of their intention to meet for organization, three successive weeks, in at least one newspaper published nearest to the place where such meeting is to be held; said notice to state the object of the meeting, and when and where it will be held, and to be signed by at least three of the persons interested in establishing such organization; said meeting to be open to the public.

SEC. 3. The articles of association adopted at the meeting provided for in the preceding section, shall specify:

First, The name, officers, and object of the association;

Second, The limit of property;

Third, The limit of subscription of members;

Fourth, The town, city, village, county, district or extent of the territory in which the operations of the society may be carried on, or to which they are limited.

SEC. 4. The articles of association, duly signed by each original member, together with the certificate, signed by the secretary, stating the amount of subscription paid in, must be registered in the office where the association is located, in a book kept for that purpose, and a copy of the same must be forwarded to the Secretary of State.

SEC. 5. On complying with the requirements of this act as above specified, the association so organized shall be a body corporate, and shall be capable of holding such real estate and personal property as may be necessary to carry out the objects of such society: of suing and being sued in any court of this State: may have a common seal, and may alter or amend the same at pleasure, and be subject to the general laws of the State applicable to such societies: may make such by-laws and regulations, not inconsistent with its articles or with the laws of this State, as may be necessary to promote the efficiency of the organization.

SEC. 6. Should a State association be organized under this act, it shall be the duty of the secretary of said State society to make and transmit to the State Librarian a report of the transactions of said society, including copies of papers read at its meetings or

contributed by its members of facts collected by correspondence or otherwise, at the end of the month of September of each year.

SEC. 7. District or county, town, city, or village associations organized under this act are hereby required to report through their secretary in the month of September in each year, to the secretary of the State association, the proceedings of said society, during the year, giving copies of papers read at its meetings or contributed by its members during the preceding year; such report from district, county, town, city, or village societies to be used in compiling the report of the State association provided for in section six. All collections of documents, periodicals, newspapers, books, maps, pictures, specimens, and curiosities which may be made by said State society, shall be placed in the State Library in charge of the State Librarian, and shall be regarded as belonging to the State whenever said society may be dissolved, or for any cause discontinue its organization.

SEC. 8. This act shall take immediate effect.

Approved April 25, 1873.

CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE 1. The name of this association shall be the Michigan Pioneer and Historical Society.

ART. 2. The officers of this society shall be a President, a corresponding Secretary, a Recording Secretary, a Treasurer, an Executive Committee of three members* and one Vice President from each local or county society, which shall be represented by delegates or representatives, according to the articles of association and by-laws; all of whom shall be elected annually, and shall serve until their successors are chosen. The election of the officers shall be prescribed by the by-laws.

ART. 3. The object of forming this association is for the purpose of collecting and preserving historical, biographical, or other information in relation to the State of Michigan.

ART. 4. The property of this association shall not exceed \$100,000.

ART. 5. This society shall embrace, as territorial limits, the State of Michigan.

*A committee of Historians of five members was provided for at the annual meeting February 2, 1876, by resolution, whose duties are to make such collections of historical facts in regard to Michigan as they may be able, and to arrange the materials collected by the society for publication (see Vol. 1, p. 57.)

ART. 6. The annual meetings of this society shall be held at Lansing, on the first Wednesday in February of each year, or at such time as the society may determine at any annual meeting at which time the President, Secretaries, and Treasurer shall each present full written reports; officers shall be elected for the ensuing year; and any general business may be transacted. Special meetings may be called, as the by-laws may provide.

ART. 7. Any person not less than 40 years of age, who has resided in Michigan for 25 years, may become a member of this society on subscribing to the articles of association, and on payment of one dollar. And all members in good standing shall be eligible to office. The privilege of voting shall be restricted to officers of the society, and to representatives from county and municipal societies, each society represented being entitled to three votes, to be cast as the society represented may determine. County and municipal societies to be entitled to representation shall (except as hereinafter provided) require like conditions of membership as are required of members of this society. Counties which have not been organized for 25 years shall be entitled to representation in this society by societies composed of persons who were residents of such counties at the date of their organization.

ART. 8. Amendments to these articles of association may be made at any regular meeting, by a majority vote of all the members present, provided the proposed amendments shall have been filed in

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writing with the Recording Secretary, and notice thereof given at the last preceding meeting, and at least one month prior to the time when the proposed amendments shall be called up for action. By-laws may be made, altered, or amended at any meeting on like conditions as to filing and notice, by a majority vote of the members present, and without previous notice, by a two-thirds vote of the members present at any regular meeting. By-laws may be temporarily suspended at any meeting by a unanimous vote of the members present.

BY-LAWS.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

SECTION 1. The President shall preside at all meetings of the society; preserve order, and see that business is conducted according to parliamentary usages. He shall be *ex officio* Chairman of the Executive Committee, and countersign all warrants drawn by the Recording Secretary upon the Treasurer upon accounts that have been audited and allowed by the Executive Committee, and shall perform such other duties as usually pertain to the office of president of such associations.

SEC. 2. The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct all correspondence of the society, and be the organ of communication between this society and other societies, persons, and bodies, and perform such other duties as shall be assigned to him by vote of the society or by direction of the Executive Committee.

SEC. 3. The Recording Secretary shall keep an accurate record of all proceedings of the society and of the Executive Committee, in books to be provided for the purpose, and he shall record the articles of association at length in a book to be provided for the purpose; which articles each member shall sign, giv-

ing place and date of birth, place and date of first residence in Michigan, present residence, with a blank for place and date of death, which blank shall be filled by said Secretary at the decease of any member. He shall record and safely keep all papers, documents, and materials presented to or that may belong to the society. He shall draw all warrants on the Treasurer on properly audited accounts, and he shall take and preserve a proper voucher therefor, and perform such other duties as may be required by vote of the society or directed by the executive committee, and perform the duties required by the act under which this association is organized.

SEC. 4. The Treasurer shall have the custody of all money and funds of the society, and safely keep the same, pay all warrants drawn on him by the Secretary and countersigned by the President; keep a full and accurate account of all receipts and disbursements, and make full report thereof at each annual meeting, and whenever required so to do by the Executive Committee. If required by vote of the society or by the Executive Committee he shall give bonds in such amount and with such securities as the society or Executive Committee shall require.

SEC. 5. The Executive Committee shall have the general management of the affairs of the society in pursuance with the articles of association, the by-laws, and the votes and resolutions of the society. They may call extra meetings of the society, at such time, place, and for such purpose (not inconsistent with the articles of association) as they may deem advisable, on

giving at least one months' previous notice by publishing the same in three different papers, published in three different countries, one of which papers shall be published at the proposed place of meeting. The society may by vote direct the time and place of holding one or more social gatherings annually, notice of which should be published as above provided.

SEC. 6. The Vice Presidents shall assist the President at the meetings. In case of the absence of the President, or his inability to act at any meeting, the Senior Vice President shall preside. The Vice Presidents are expected to be especially active in their various counties in promoting the objects of this society.

SEC. 7. Vacancies in the office of President, Corresponding or Recording Secretary, Treasurer or Executive Committee, may be filled until the next annual meeting by the Executive Committee and any three Vice Presidents of this society.
