Calvin Baptist Church

The History of Carroll County, New Hampshire, states that the first Church in Sandwich, N. H. was located at North Sandwich. It was a Calvin Baptist Society. In early days Elder Jacob Jewell, born Mch. 18, 1737, came from Weare, N. H. and went to Sandwich, prior to 1776, and was preaching there in 1780.

About 1798, the "Baptist Historian", was established, and Elder Jewell preached the "Doctrine of Election". In 1802 they had a new meeting house.

In 1839, the Church was divided, and the Free-will Baptist, separated from the Calvin, and remodeled the Church.

Hilton Cemetery is on the crest of the hill close to the stone wall adjoining the Stephan Vittum property, now owned by the Rev. Edmund March Vittum as a summer residence. A child of David Hill is buried here also one of John Hilton and four children of James Tappan, part of them reached maturity.

South of the former site of the Beede-Hoyt home, on a knoll in a pine grove, is the quarter acre yard of Dr. Moses Hoyt.

The stones mostly have been wantonly removed from the various mounds. Three were marked with uninscribed field stones. One was of Dr. Moses Hoyt who died Aug. 24, 1863 aged 90 yrs. His wife was Anne Beede Hoyt and presumably is buried here. The stone of their daughter Sarah B. states she died Mar. 31, 1873 aged 73 years.

The broken slate slab of Aaron Beede who was Mrs. Hoyt's father is tipped against a rock in the pasture below. It states he died Oct. 7, 1789, aged 34 years.

THE FRIEND'S CHURCH.

History states that the "Friend's, went to Sandwich, N. H. about 1777; they formed a Society of about forty members, migrating from Dover; Rochester; Epping, and adjoining towns, from 1802 - 1833; there were not less than seventy members. The names enrolled were:

Hoag; Beede; Varney; Meader; Hoit; Felch; Brown; Dealing; Jewett; Scribner; Wingate; Bunker; Jenness; Folsom; Heard; Hill; Hinds; Marston; Dow; Dean; Gould; Roberts; Frye; Miller; Johnson; and many others.

Ezra Meader, and Stephen Beede, were each Clerks about sixty years and clerks of the Dover Quarterly Meetings also.

The Society met twice a week for worship in their churches, regardless of weather conditions, meditating in silence on their lives, and the blessings God had bestowed upon them; they have given us this adage: "SILENCE IS GOLDEN".

The Friends were all people of sterling quality, and lived the quiet religious life. Their influence has followed them thru the descendants.

"EZRA MEADER", was the first Preacher, and for a time spoke from "Meader, or Pulpit Rock"; they erected a Church in 1814, with this inscription:

THE FRIENDS CHURCH.

MOTTO

JESUS TAUGHT THAT

RELIGION

IS SUMMED UP IN

LOVE TO GOD
AND

LOVE TO MAN.

The "Friends, or Quaker Burial Ground", is not far beyond the Church.

It is located on a hill, protected by mountains, that guard it from storms; the hill slopes down to a brook where sing babbling waters a lullaby to those who rest here, in this beautiful spot with old trees to protect their graves. Four generations rest here, who were true

The Friend's Church

to their faith, and lived as they preached.

The yard is very neatly kept by descendants, who respect their ancestors.

On the side of the yard where the Friends rest, are many field stones, hewn and chiseled with initials, and a few have dates.

When these Friends were laid to rest, no marble stones could be procured, at that early time, and many graves are only marked with a plain stone, so their names are lost to us.
